<u>Rom. 12:1</u> ¶ Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, **to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God,** *which is* your spiritual service of worship.

<u>1 Cor. 6:19</u> Or do you not know that **your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit** who is in you, whom you have from God, and that **you are not your own?** 

**Eph. 4:30 Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God**, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

<u>1 Pet. 1:15, 16</u> but like the Holy One who called you, be holy yourselves also in all *your* behavior; <u>16</u> because it is written, "YOU SHALL BE HOLY, FOR I AM HOLY."

<u>John 3:16</u> ¶ "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

Rom. 5:8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

<u>1 John 3:1-3</u> ¶ See how great a love the Father has bestowed on us, that we would be called children of God; and *such* we are. For this reason the world does not know us, because it did not know Him. <u>2 Beloved, now we are children of God</u>, and it has not appeared as yet what we will be. We know that when He appears, we will be like Him, because we will see Him just as He is. <u>3</u> And everyone who has this hope *fixed* on Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.

1 John 4:19 We love, because He first loved us.

**Eph. 2:8-10 8** For **by grace you have been saved** through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* **the gift of God**; **9** not as a result of works, so that no one may boast. **10** For **we are His workmanship**, created in Christ Jesus **for good works**, which God prepared beforehand **so that we would walk in them**.

**<u>2 Cor. 1:3</u>** ¶ Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, **the Father of mercies** and God of all comfort.

Rom. 15:9 and for the Gentiles to glorify God for His mercy; as it is written, "THEREFORE I WILL GIVE PRAISE TO YOU AMONG THE GENTILES, AND I WILL SING TO YOUR NAME."

<u>1 Cor. 1:9</u> God is faithful, through whom you were called into fellowship with His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

<u>1 Cor. 10:13</u> No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, so that you will be able to endure it.

Matt. 22:37 And He said to him, "YOU SHALL LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND."

Rom. 8:28 ¶ And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to *His* purpose.

**Eph. 5:2** and **walk in love**, **just as Christ also loved you** and gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God as a fragrant aroma.

<u>1 Thess. 4:9</u> ¶ Now as to the love of the brethren, you have no need for *anyone* to write to you, for you yourselves are taught by God to love one another;

<u>Heb. 6:10</u> For God is not unjust so as to forget your work and the love which you have shown toward His name, in having ministered and in still ministering to the saints.

1 John 4:11 Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.

<u>Rom. 6:16</u> Do you not know that when you present yourselves to someone *as* slaves for obedience, you are slaves of the one whom you obey, either of sin resulting in death, or of obedience resulting in righteousness?

<u>2 Cor. 10:5</u> We are destroying speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the knowledge of God, and we are taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ,

**Rom. 6:12**  $\P$  Therefore **do not let sin reign** in your mortal body **so that you obey** its lusts.

<u>Psa. 90:10</u> As for the days of our life, they contain seventy years, Or if due to strength, eighty years, Yet their pride is *but* labor and sorrow; For soon it is gone and we fly away.
