<u>Mark 6:1</u> ¶ Jesus went out from there and came into His hometown; and His disciples followed Him.

<u>Matt. 13:54</u> He came to His hometown and *began* teaching them in their synagogue, so that they were astonished, and said, "Where *did* this man *get* this wisdom and *these* miraculous powers?

<u>Mark 6:2</u> When the Sabbath came, He began to teach in the synagogue; and the many listeners were astonished, saying, "Where did this man *get* these things, and what is *this* wisdom given to Him, and such miracles as these performed by His hands?

Luke 4:20-30 20 ¶ And He closed the book, gave it back to the attendant and sat down; and the eyes of all in the synagogue were fixed on Him. **21** And He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing." 22 And all were speaking well of Him, and wondering at the gracious words which were falling from His lips; and they were saying, "Is this not Joseph's son?" 23 And He said to them, "No doubt you will quote this proverb to Me, 'Physician, heal yourself! Whatever we heard was done at Capernaum, do here in your hometown as well."" **24** And He said, "Truly I say to you, no prophet is welcome in his hometown. 25 "But I say to you in truth, there were many widows in Israel in the days of Elijah, when the sky was shut up for three years and six months, when a great famine came over all the land; 26 and yet Elijah was sent to none of them, but only to Zarephath, in the land of Sidon, to a woman who was a widow. 27 "And there were many lepers in Israel in the time of Elisha the prophet; and none of them was cleansed, but only Naaman the Syrian." 28 And all the people in the synagogue were filled with rage as they heard 29 and they got up and drove Him out of the city, and led Him to the these things; brow of the hill on which their city had been built, in order to throw Him down the 30 But passing through their midst, He went His way. cliff.

<u>Matt. 13:55</u> "Is not this **the carpenter's son?** Is not **His mother called Mary**, and His **brothers**, James and Joseph and Simon and Judas?

<u>Matt. 13:56</u> "And His sisters, are they not all with us? Where then *did* this man *get* all these things?"

<u>Mark 6:3</u> "Is not this **the carpenter**, the son of Mary, and brother of **James** and **Joses** and **Judas** and **Simon**? Are not **His sisters here with us**?" And they took offense at Him.

<u>John 8:41</u> "You are doing the **deeds of your father**." They said to Him, "We were not born of fornication; we have one Father: God."

John 9:29 "We know that God has spoken to Moses, but as for this man, we do not know where He is from."

Matt. 13:57 And they took offense at Him. But Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor except in his hometown and in his *own* household."

<u>Mark 6:4</u> Jesus said to them, "A prophet is **not without honor except** in his hometown and **among his** *own* **relatives** and in his *own* household."

Matt. 13:58 And He did not do many miracles there because of their unbelief.

<u>Mark 6:5</u> And He could do no miracle there **except that He laid His hands on a few** sick people and healed them.

<u>Mark 6:6</u> And **He wondered at their unbelief**. ¶ And He was going around the villages teaching.
