**Eph. 6:1** ¶ Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.

<u>Col. 3:20</u> Children, be obedient to your parents in all things, for this is well-pleasing to the Lord.

**Eph. 6:2** HONOR YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER (which is the first commandment with a promise),

**Ex. 21:15** ¶ "He who strikes his father or his mother shall surely be put to death.

<u>Eph. 6:3</u> SO THAT IT MAY BE WELL WITH YOU, AND THAT YOU MAY LIVE LONG ON THE EARTH.

<u>Eph. 6:4</u> ¶ Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

Col. 3:21 Fathers, do not exasperate your children, so that they will not lose heart.

<u>**Prov. 22:15</u>** Foolishness is bound up in the heart of a child; The rod of discipline will remove it far from him.</u>

<u>**Prov. 23:13</u> \P Do not hold back discipline** from the child, Although you strike him with the rod, he will not die.</u>

**Prov. 23:14** You shall strike him with the rod And rescue his soul from Sheol.

<u>**Prov. 13:24</u>** He who withholds his rod **hates his son**, But **he who loves him** disciplines him diligently.</u>

<u>**Prov. 29:15</u>** The **rod and reproof give wisdom**, But a child who **gets his own way** brings shame to his mother.</u>

<u>Heb. 12:5-11</u> <u>5</u> and you have forgotten the exhortation which is addressed **to you as sons**, "MY SON, DO NOT REGARD LIGHTLY **THE DISCIPLINE OF THE LORD**, NOR FAINT WHEN YOU ARE REPROVED BY HIM; <u>6</u> FOR THOSE **WHOM THE LORD LOVES HE DISCIPLINES**, AND HE SCOURGES EVERY SON WHOM HE RECEIVES." **<u>Heb. 12:7</u>** It is for discipline that you endure; **God deals with you as with sons**; for what son is there whom *his* father does not discipline? **<u>8</u> But if you are without discipline**, of which all have become partakers, then **you are illegitimate children and not sons**. **<u>9</u>** Furthermore, we had **earthly fathers to discipline us**, and **we respected them;** shall we not much rather **be subject to the Father of spirits, and live**? **<u>10</u>** For they disciplined us for a short time as seemed best to them, **but He** *disciplines us* **for** *our* **good, so that we may share His holiness**. **<u>11</u>** All discipline for the moment seems not to be joyful, but sorrowful; **yet to those who have been trained by it,** afterwards it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness.

**Eph. 6:5-7 5** ¶ **Slaves, be obedient** to those who are **your masters** according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in the **sincerity of your heart**, **as to Christ**;

**<u>Eph. 6:6</u>** not by way of eyeservice, as men-pleasers, but as slaves of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart.

**Eph. 6:7** With good will render service, as to the Lord, and not to men,

**<u>Eph. 6:8</u>** knowing that **whatever good thing each one does**, this he will receive back **from the Lord, whether slave or free**.

**Col. 3:23, 24 23** Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men, **24** knowing **that from the Lord you will receive the reward** of the inheritance. **It is the Lord Christ whom you serve.**

<u>Eph. 6:9</u>  $\P$  And masters, do the same things to them, and give up threatening, knowing that both their Master and yours is in heaven, and there is no partiality with Him.

**<u>Rom. 2:11</u>** For there is **no partiality with God**.
