Ex. 21:16 ¶ "He who **kidnaps** a man, whether **he sells him** or he is found in his possession, **shall surely be put to death**.

Ex. 21:26 ¶ "If a man strikes the eye of his male or female slave, and destroys it, he shall let him go free on account of his eye.

Ex. 21:27 "And if he knocks out a tooth of his male or female slave, he shall let him go free on account of his tooth.

<u>Lev. 25:10</u> 'You shall thus **consecrate the fiftieth year** and **proclaim a release** through the land to all its inhabitants. It shall be a jubilee for you, and **each of you shall return to his own property, and each of you shall return to his family.**

Eph. 5:21 and **be subject to one another** in the fear of Christ.

Eph. 6:5-7 ¶ **Slaves, be obedient** to those who are **your masters** according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in the **sincerity of your heart**, **as to Christ**;

<u>1 Pet. 2:18-20</u> <u>18</u> ¶ Servants, be submissive to your masters with all respect, not only to those who are good and gentle, but also **to those who are unreasonable**.

<u>19</u> For this *finds* favor, if for the **sake of conscience toward God** a person bears up under sorrows when suffering unjustly. <u>20</u> For **what credit is there if, when you sin** and are harshly treated, you endure it with patience? But if **when you do what is right** and suffer *for it* you patiently endure it, **this** *finds* **favor with God**.

<u>1 Tim. 6:1, 2</u> ¶ All who are under the yoke as slaves are to regard their own masters as worthy of all honor so that the name of God and our doctrine will not be spoken against. <u>2</u> Those who have believers as their masters must not be disrespectful to them because they are brethren, but must serve them all the more, because those who partake of the benefit are believers and beloved. Teach and preach these principles.

<u>Titus 2:9, 10 9</u> ¶ *Urge* bondslaves to be subject to their own masters in everything, to be well-pleasing, not argumentative, 10 not pilfering, but showing all good faith so that they will adorn the doctrine of God our Savior in every respect.

<u>Eph. 6:6</u> not by way of eyeservice, as men-pleasers, but as slaves of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart.

Eph. 6:7 With good will render service, as to the Lord, and not to men,

Eph. 6:8 knowing that **whatever good thing each one does**, this he will receive back **from the Lord**, **whether slave or free**.

Col. 3:23, 24 23 Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men, 24 knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance. It is the Lord Christ whom you serve.

Eph. 6:9 ¶ And **masters, do the same things to them**, and give up threatening, knowing that **both their Master and yours is in heaven**, and there is **no partiality with Him.**

Rom. 2:11 For there is no partiality with God.

<u>James 2:9</u> But if you show partiality, you are committing sin *and* are convicted by the law as transgressors.

Eph. 5:18 And do not get drunk with wine, for that is dissipation, **but be filled with the Spirit**,
