 - 1. The Person who believes in Christ will not come under God's Eternal Judgment, v-18a
 - 2. The Person who does not believe in Christ is already under God's Eternal Judgment, because he has not taken God's way of escape in Christ, v-18b; Acts 17:30, 31
 - 3. The whole human race is under God's condemnation, Rom. 3:23; 5:18
- III. THEREFORE GOD'S TRUE DISCIPLES MUST TAKE THE GOOD NEWS OF SALVATION IN CHRIST TO THE ENDS OF THE EARTH, Acts 1:8
 - A. We Must Begin At Home First, Acts 1:8
 --We are to bear witness of our Savior!
 Mt. 10:32; Lk. 9:26

- B. The Lord Wants His Disciples To Take The Gospel To All The Nations And Make Disciples, Mt. 28:18-20
 - 1. He sends us with His Authority, v-18
 - 2. We are to lead them to Christ, v-19a
 - 3. We are to baptize them in the Name of the Triune God, v-19b -- The Trinity!
 - 4. We are to teach them to observe <u>all</u> that the Lord commanded, v-20a
 - --We who are at home are to become disciples of Christ also. --Growing believers
 - 5. Every generation is expected to carry the message of salvation to every nation in their day, v-20b
- C. The Lord Appointed An Apostle To The Gentiles To Fulfill The Father's Will
 - 1. He Chose Paul, Acts 26:15-18
 - 2. The Jewish rejection of the message of salvation in Christ caused Paul to go full time after the Gentiles, Acts 13:44-48
