<u>John 8:24</u> "Therefore I said to you that **you will die in your sins**; for unless you believe that I am *He*, **you will die in your sins**."

<u>John 14:6</u> Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

Acts 4:10-12 10 let it be known to all of you and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead — by this name this man stands here before you in good health. 11 "He is the STONE WHICH WAS REJECTED by you, THE BUILDERS, but WHICH BECAME THE CHIEF CORNER stone. 12 "And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved."

<u>1 Tim. 2:3-7</u> This is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, <u>4</u> who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. <u>5</u> For there is one God, and one mediator also between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,

<u>6</u> who gave Himself as a ransom for all, the testimony *given* at the proper time. <u>7</u> For this I was appointed a preacher and an apostle (I am telling the truth, I am not lying) as a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth.

- <u>1 Pet. 1:18-20</u> <u>18</u> knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, <u>19</u> but with **precious blood**, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, *the blood* of Christ.
- **20** For He was **foreknown before the foundation of the world**, but has appeared in these last times for the sake of you

John 1:29 ¶ The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!

<u>John 3:16</u> ¶ "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

Eph. 2:4 But God, being rich in mercy, **because of His great love** with which He loved us,

Rom. 5:8 But **God demonstrates His own love toward us**, in that while we were yet sinners, **Christ died for us**. **9** Much more then, having **now been justified by His blood**, we shall **be saved from the wrath** *of God* through Him.

<u>John 3:16b...</u> that whoever **believes in Him** shall not perish, **but have eternal life**.

<u>John 3:17</u> "For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him.

<u>1 Tim. 2:4</u> who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

<u>John 3:18</u> "He who believes in Him is not judged; he who does not believe has been judged already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

Acts 17:30, 31 30 "Therefore having overlooked the times of ignorance, God is now declaring to men that all people everywhere should repent, 31 because He has fixed a day in which He will judge the world in righteousness through a Man whom He has appointed, having furnished proof to all men by raising Him from the dead."

Rom. 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Rom. 5:18 ¶ So then as through one transgression there resulted condemnation to all men, even so through one act of righteousness there resulted justification of life to all men.

Acts 1:8 but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth."

Matt. 10:32 ¶ "Therefore everyone who confesses Me before men, I will also confess him before My Father who is in heaven.

<u>Luke 9:26</u> "For whoever is **ashamed of Me and My words**, the Son of Man **will be ashamed of him** when He comes in His glory, and *the glory* of the Father and of the holy angels.

Matt. 28:18-20 18 And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit,

20 teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Acts 26:15--18 15 "And I said, 'Who are You, Lord?' And the Lord said, 'I am Jesus whom you are persecuting. 16 'But get up and stand on your feet; for this purpose I have appeared to you, to appoint you a minister and a witness not only to the things which you have seen, but also to the things in which I will appear to you; 17 rescuing you from the Jewish people and from the Gentiles, to whom I am sending you, 18 to open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.'

Acts 13:44-48 44 ¶ The next Sabbath nearly the whole city assembled to hear the word of the Lord. 45 But when the Jews saw the crowds, they were filled with jealousy and began contradicting the things spoken by Paul, and were blaspheming. 46 Paul and Barnabas spoke out boldly and said, "It was necessary that the word of God be spoken to you first; since you repudiate it and judge yourselves unworthy of eternal life, behold, we are turning to the Gentiles. 47 "For so the Lord has commanded us, 'I HAVE PLACED YOU AS A LIGHT FOR THE GENTILES, THAT YOU MAY BRING SALVATION TO THE END OF THE EARTH."

Acts 13:48 ¶ When the Gentiles heard this, they began rejoicing and glorifying the word of the Lord; and as many as had been appointed to eternal life believed.
