III. HE GAVE THEM SPECIFIC MINISTRIES TO DO,
v-8 --He is giving them authority and power to do that
which only God could do.

- A. To Miraculously Heal The Sick, v-8a
- B. To Raise The Dead, v-8b
- C. To Cleanse The Lepers, v-8c
- D. To Cast Out Demons, v-8d

- E. Earlier, He Revealed That Satan would later
counterfeit these ministries through his false
teachers and workers, Mt.:7:21-23

- F. They Were Not To Charge For Their Ministry,
v-8e
 - 1. Remember Judas was among them with the
same authority and power!
 - 2. Judas was a thief, and would have, no doubt,
wanted to receive money for his ministry,
Cf. Jn. 12:6
 - 3. This is not an excuse to not support those
that God would call into His Ministry later!
Cf. 1 Tim. 5:17, 18

IV. HE INSTRUCTED THEM TO TOTALLY DEPEND
UPON HIM IN THEIR MINISTRY, v-9-

- A. To Not Depend On Their Own Financial Ability,
v-9, 10a; Lk. 9:3

B. To Depend Upon God's People To Do The Right
Thing, v-Mt. 10b-12

- 1. To provide their needs during the time
of their ministry, v-10b

- 2. To provide hospitality for them, v-11, 12

- 3. To seek to acknowledge worthy people in
regard to hospitality, v-11
 - a. They were to bless those who blessed
them, v-12, 13a; Mk. 6:10; Lk. 9:4
 - b. They were to testify against those
who rejected their ministry,
Mt. 10:13b, 14; Mk. 6:11; Lk. 9:5
 - c. He wanted them to know that God
will judge those people who rejected
their ministry, v-15

V. THEY CARRIED OUT THEIR GOD GIVEN
MINISTRY, Mk. 6:12, 13

- A. They Preached, v-12

- B. They Ministered As Instructed , v-13: Lk.9:6
