Sunday, March 27, 2022 Sermon Scriptures

<u>Matt. 10:5</u> ¶ These twelve Jesus sent out after instructing them: "Do not go in *the* way of *the* Gentiles, and do not enter *any* city of **the Samaritans**;

Matt. 10:6 but rather go to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

Matt. 15:24 But He answered and said, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel."

Matt. 10:7 "And as you go, preach, saying, 'The kingdom of heaven is at hand.'

Matt. 3:2 "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

<u>Matt. 4:17</u> ¶ From that time Jesus began to preach and say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

<u>John 3:3</u> Jesus answered and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, **unless one is born** again he cannot see the kingdom of God."

John 3:7 "Do not be amazed that I said to you, 'You must be born again.

<u>**Rev. 20:4**</u> ¶ Then I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them. And I *saw* the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, and those **who had not worshiped the beast or his image**, and had not received the mark on their forehead and on their hand; **and they came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.**

<u>**Rev. 20:6</u>** Blessed and holy is the one who has a part in **the first resurrection**; over these the second death has no power, but they will be **priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years.**</u>

Matt. 10:8 "Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse the lepers, cast out demons....

Matt. 7:21-23 21 ¶ "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven *will enter*. 22 "Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?' 23 "And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; DEPART FROM ME, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS.'

Matt. 10:8e . . . Freely you received, freely give.

John 12:6 Now he said this, not because he was concerned about the poor, but because he was a thief, and as he had the money box, he used to pilfer what was put into it.

<u>1 Tim. 5:17, 18</u> 17 ¶ The elders who rule well are to be considered worthy of double honor, especially those who work hard at preaching and teaching. **<u>18</u>** For the Scripture says, "YOU SHALL NOT MUZZLE THE OX WHILE HE IS THRESHING," and "The laborer is worthy of his wages."

Matt. 10:9 "Do not acquire gold, or silver, or copper for your money belts,

<u>Matt. 10:10</u> or a bag for *your* journey, or even two coats, or sandals, or a staff; for the worker is worthy of his support.

Luke 9:3 And He said to them, "**Take nothing for** *your* **journey**, neither a staff, nor a bag, nor bread, nor money; and **do not** *even* **have two tunics apiece**.

<u>Matt. 10:11</u> "And whatever city or village you enter, inquire who is worthy in it, and stay at his house until you leave *that city*.

Matt. 10:12 "As you enter the house, give it your greeting.

<u>Matt. 10:13</u> "If the house is worthy, give it your *blessing of* peace. But if it is not worthy, take back your *blessing of* peace.

<u>Mark 6:10</u> And He said to them, "Wherever you enter a house, stay there until you leave town.

Luke 9:4 "Whatever house you enter, stay there until you leave that city.

<u>Matt. 10:14</u> "Whoever does not receive you, nor heed your words, as you go out of that house or that city, shake the dust off your feet.

<u>Mark 6:11</u> "Any place that **does not receive you or listen to you**, as you go out from there, shake the dust off the soles of your feet **for a testimony against them**."

<u>Luke 9:5</u> "And as for **those who do not receive you**, as you go out from that city, shake the dust off your feet as **a testimony against them**."

<u>Matt. 10:15</u> "**Truly I say** to you, it will be more tolerable for *the* land of Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of judgment **than for that city**.

Mark 6:12 They went out and preached that *men* should repent.

<u>Mark 6:13</u> And they were casting out many demons and were anointing with oil many sick people and healing them.

<u>Luke 9:6</u> Departing, they *began* going throughout the villages, preaching the gospel and healing everywhere.
