C. In Spite Of The Persecution They Are To Keep At Task Of Preaching The Message, v-23

1. They are to go to city to city, v-23a;
Cf. Acts 14:1-7
2. They will not finish before Christ Returns, v-23b (Tribulation Setting)

III. THE LORD WARNS HIS DISCIPLES THAT THEY WILL BE PERSECUTED AS HE WAS PERSECUTED

- A. They Are Not Above Their Teacher Or Master, v-24
- B. He Tells Them That It Is Enough That They Be Like Their Teacher Or Master, v-25a
- C. If People Maligned The Head Of The Household By Calling Him Beelzebub, They Will Surely Malign The Members Of His Household, v-25b
2 Ki. 1:2; Lk. 11:15
- D. The Lord Tells Them Not To fear Those Who Persecute Them, v-26-28
1. They are to preach God's full message, v-26, 27

2. They are to fear God over men, v-28;
Cf. Lk. 12:5

E. He Tells them To Recognize How Valuable They Are To God, v-29-33

1. God watches over the sparrows of the Creation, v-29
2. God has numbered the very hairs of the heads of His Follows. v-30
3. Therefore they are not to fear because they are far more valuable than many sparrows, v-31
4. Thus they are not to fear to confess Christ when under persecution, v-32
5. He told them that those who deny Christ will be denied by Him before God the Father, v-33; Cf. 2 Tim. 2:10-13
