Deut. 18:15 ¶ "The LORD your God will raise up for you **a prophet like me** from among you, from your countrymen, **you shall listen to him**.

Deut. 18:18 'I will raise up a prophet from among their countrymen like you, **and I will put My words in his mouth**, and he shall speak to them all that I command him.

Acts 3:22, 23 22 "Moses said, 'THE LORD GOD WILL RAISE UP FOR YOU A PROPHET LIKE ME FROM YOUR BRETHREN; TO HIM YOU SHALL GIVE HEED to everything He says to you. 23 'And it will be that every soul that does not heed that prophet shall be utterly destroyed from among the people.'

<u>Isa. 53:1</u> ¶ Who has believed our message? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?

Isa. 7:14 "Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, **a virgin** will be with child and bear a son, and she will call **His name Immanuel**.

Matt. 1:21-2321"She will bear a Son; and you shall call His name Jesus, for Hewill save His people from their sins."22Now all this took place to fulfill what wasspoken by the Lord through the prophet:23"BEHOLD, THE VIRGIN SHALLBE WITH CHILD AND SHALL BEAR A SON, AND THEY SHALL CALL HISNAME IMMANUEL," which translated means, "GOD WITH US."

<u>Isa. 9:6</u> For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, **Mighty God**, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.

John 1:49 Nathanael answered Him, "Rabbi, You are the Son of God; You are the King of Israel."

<u>Matt. 2:1, 2</u> Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, magi from the east arrived in Jerusalem, saying, <u>2</u> "Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? For we saw His star in the east and have come to worship Him."

John 6:38 "For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

John 10:36 do you say of Him, whom the Father sanctified and sent into the world, 'You are blaspheming,' because I said, 'I am the Son of God'?

<u>Matt. 27:43</u> "HE TRUSTS IN GOD; LET GOD RESCUE *Him* now, IF HE DELIGHTS IN HIM; for **He said, 'I am the Son of God**.""

John 11:27 She said to Him, "Yes, Lord; I have believed that You are the Christ, the Son of God, *even* He who comes into the world."

John 8:56-5956"Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, and he saw *it* and
was glad."57So the Jews said to Him, "You are not yet fifty years old, and have You
seen Abraham?"58Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham
So Therefore they picked up stones to throw at Him, but
Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple.

<u>Matt. 20:28</u> just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, **but to serve, and to give** His life a ransom for many."

<u>Luke 19:10</u> "For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."

<u>John 9:1-3</u> ¶ As He passed by, He saw a man blind from birth. <u>2</u> And His disciples asked Him, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he would be born blind?" <u>3</u> Jesus answered, "*It was* neither *that* this man sinned, nor his parents; but *it was* so that the works of God might be displayed in him.

John 9:6-11 <u>6</u> When He had said this, He spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and applied the clay to his eyes, <u>7</u> and said to him, "Go, wash in the pool of Siloam" (which is translated, Sent). So he went away and washed, and came *back* seeing. <u>8</u> Therefore the neighbors, and those who previously saw him as a beggar, were saying, "Is not this the one who used to sit and beg?" <u>9</u> Others were saying, "This is he," *still* others were saying, "No, but he is like him." He kept saying, "I am the one." <u>10</u> So they were saying to him, "How then were your eyes opened?" <u>11</u> He answered, "The man who is called Jesus made clay, and anointed my eyes, and said to me, 'Go to Siloam and wash'; so I went away and washed, and I received sight."

<u>John 9:31-33</u> <u>31</u> "We know that God **does not hear sinners**; but if anyone is Godfearing and does His will, He hears him. <u>32</u> "**Since the beginning of time** it has **never been heard** that anyone opened the eyes of a person born blind. <u>33</u> "If this man were not from God, He could do nothing."

John 11:35-45 35 Jesus wept. <u>36</u> So the Jews were saying, "See how He loved him!"

John 11:37 But some of them said, "Could not this man, who opened the eyes of the blind man, have kept this man also from dying?" **38** ¶ So Jesus, again being deeply moved within, came to the tomb. Now it was a cave, and a stone was lying against it. **39** Jesus said, "**Remove the stone**." Martha, the sister of the deceased, said to Him, "Lord, by this time there will be a stench, for he has been dead four days." **40** Jesus said to her, "Did I not say to you that if you believe, you will see the glory of God?" 41 So they removed the stone. Then Jesus raised His eyes, and said, "Father, I thank You 42 "I knew that You always hear Me; but because of the that You have heard Me. people standing around I said it, so that they may believe that You sent Me." 43 When He had said these things, He cried out with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come forth." 44 The man who had died came forth, bound hand and foot with wrappings, and his face was wrapped around with a cloth. John 6:44, 4544"No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me drawshim; and I will raise him up on the last day.45"It is written in the prophets, 'ANDTHEY SHALL ALL BE TAUGHT OF GOD.' Everyone who has heard and learnedfrom the Father, comes to Me.

<u>Matt. 23:13-15</u> <u>13</u> ¶ "But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites, because you shut off the kingdom of heaven from people; for you do not enter in yourselves, nor do you allow those who are entering to go in. <u>14</u> ["Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites, because you devour widows' houses, and for a pretense you make long prayers; therefore you will receive greater condemnation.] <u>15</u> ¶ "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites, because you travel around on sea and land to make one proselyte; and when he becomes one, you make him twice as much a son of hell as yourselves.

Matt. 3:1-3 1 ¶ Now in those days John the Baptist came, preaching in the wilderness of Judea, saying, 2 "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." 3 For this is the one referred to by Isaiah the prophet when he said, "THE VOICE OF ONE CRYING IN THE WILDERNESS, 'MAKE READY THE WAY OF THE LORD, MAKE HIS PATHS STRAIGHT!"

<u>Matt. 3:7</u> ¶ But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees coming for baptism, he said to them, "You brood of vipers, who warned you to flee from the wrath to come?

John 3:28 "You yourselves are my witnesses that I said, 'I am not the Christ,' but, 'I have been sent ahead of Him.'

John 8:24 "Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for unless you believe that I am *He*, you will die in your sins."

<u>Matt. 21:6-8</u> <u>6</u> The disciples went and did just as Jesus had instructed them, <u>7</u> and brought the donkey and the colt, and laid their coats on them; and He sat on the coats. <u>8</u> Most of the crowd spread their coats in the road, and others were cutting branches from the trees and spreading them in the road.

Mark 11:9, 10 9 Those who went in front and those who followed were shouting: "Hosanna! BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD; 10 Blessed *is* the coming kingdom of our father David; Hosanna in the highest!"

<u>Matt. 21:9</u> The crowds going ahead of Him, and those who followed, were shouting, "Hosanna to the Son of David; BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD; Hosanna in the highest!"

Luke 19:37-4437As soon as He was approaching, near the descent of the Mount of
Olives, the whole crowd of the disciples began to praise God joyfully with a loud voice
for all the miracles which they had seen, 38
shouting: "BLESSED IS THE KING
WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD; Peace in heaven and glory in the

When He approached Jerusalem, He saw the city and wept
over it,

<u>42</u> saying, "If you had known in this day, even you, the things which make for peace! But **now they have been hidden from your eyes**. <u>43</u> "For the days will come upon you when your enemies will throw up a barricade against you, and surround you and hem you in on every side, <u>44</u> and they will level you to the ground **and your children within you**, and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, **because you did not recognize the time of your visitation**."

<u>Matt. 27:15-17</u> <u>15</u> Now at *the* feast **the governor was accustomed to release** for the people *any* one prisoner whom they wanted. <u>16</u> At that time they were holding a **notorious prisoner, called Barabbas**. <u>17</u> So when the people gathered together, Pilate said to them, "Whom do you want me to release for you? **Barabbas, or Jesus who is called Christ?**"

Matt. 27:20-25 20 But the chief priests and the elders persuaded the crowds to ask for Barabbas and to put Jesus to death. 21 But the governor said to them, "Which of the two do you want me to release for you?" And they said, "Barabbas." 22 Pilate said to them, "Then what shall I do with Jesus who is called Christ?" They all said, "Crucify Him!" 23 And he said, "Why, what evil has He done?" But they kept shouting all the more, saying, "Crucify Him!"

<u>Matt.27:24</u> ¶ When Pilate saw that he was accomplishing nothing, but rather that a riot was starting, he took water and washed his hands in front of the crowd, saying, "I am innocent of this Man's blood; see *to that* yourselves." <u>25</u> And **all the people said**, "His blood shall be **on us and on our children**!"

<u>Acts 2:36-41</u> <u>36</u> ¶ "Therefore let all the house of Israel know for certain that God has made Him both Lord and Christ — **this Jesus whom you crucified.**"

<u>37</u> ¶ Now when they heard *this,* they were **pierced to the heart**, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brethren, **what shall we do?**"

<u>38</u> Peter *said* to them, "**Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins;** and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

<u>39</u> "For the promise is for you and your children and **for all who are far off**, as many **as the Lord our God will call to Himself.**"

<u>40</u> And with many other words he solemnly testified and kept on exhorting them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation!"

<u>41</u> So then, **those who had received his word** were baptized; and that day there were added about **three thousand souls**.
