Sunday, May 8, 2022 Sermon Scriptures

<u>Luke 19:10</u> "For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."

Rom. 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Rom. 5:18 \P So then as through one transgression there resulted condemnation to all men, even so through one act of righteousness there resulted justification of life to all men.

John 3:16-18 16 ¶ "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life. 17 "For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him. 18 "He who believes in Him is not judged; he who does not believe has been judged already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

Rom. 12:1, 2 1 ¶ Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship. 2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

<u>1 Thess. 4:1-5</u> <u>1</u> ¶ Finally then, brethren, we request and exhort you in the Lord Jesus, that as you received from us *instruction* as to how you ought to walk and please God (just as you actually do walk), that you excel still more. <u>2</u> For you know what commandments we gave you by *the authority of* the Lord Jesus. <u>3</u> For this is the will of God, your sanctification; *that is*, that you abstain from sexual immorality; <u>4</u> that each of you know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor, <u>5</u> not in lustful passion, like the Gentiles who do not know God;

<u>2 Cor. 12:21</u> I am afraid that when I come again my God may humiliate me before you, and I may mourn over many of those who have sinned in the past and not repented of the impurity, immorality and sensuality which they have practiced.

<u>1 John 1:9</u> If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Rom. 6:11-13 11 Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus. 12 \P Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its lusts,

Rom. 6:13 and do not go on presenting the members of your body to sin *as* instruments of unrighteousness; but present yourselves to God as those alive from the dead, and your members *as* instruments of righteousness to God.

<u>1 Pet. 2:1, 2</u> ¶ Therefore, putting aside all malice and all deceit and hypocrisy and envy and all slander, $\underline{2}$ like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may grow in respect to salvation,

<u>2 Pet. 3:18</u> but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him *be* the glory, both now and to the day of eternity. Amen.

Gen. 2:18, 19 18 ¶ Then the LORD God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone; I will make him a helper suitable for him." 19 Out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the sky, and brought *them* to the man to see what he would call them; and whatever the man called a living creature, that was its name.

<u>Gen. 3:20</u> ¶ Now the man called his wife's name Eve, because she was the mother of all *the* living.

2 Tim. 1:5 For I am mindful of the sincere faith within you, which first dwelt in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice, and I am sure that *it is* in you as well.

<u>Titus 2:3-5</u> 3 ¶ Older women likewise are to be reverent in their behavior, not malicious gossips nor enslaved to much wine, teaching what is good, $\underline{4}$ so that they may encourage the young women to love their husbands, to love their children, $\underline{5}$ to be sensible, pure, workers at home, kind, being subject to their own husbands, so that the word of God will not be dishonored.

<u>1 Pet. 3:1-4</u> <u>1</u> ¶ In the same way, you wives, be submissive to your own husbands so that even if any *of them* are disobedient to the word, they may be won without a word by the behavior of their wives, <u>2</u> as they observe your chaste and respectful behavior. <u>3</u> Your adornment must not be *merely* external — braiding the hair, and wearing gold jewelry, or putting on dresses; <u>4</u> but *let it be* the hidden person of the heart, with the imperishable quality of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is precious in the sight of God.

 $\underline{Ex. 20:12}$ ¶ "Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be prolonged in the land which the LORD your God gives you.

Eph. 6:2 HONOR YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER (which is the first commandment with a promise),

Ex. 21:15, 17 15 ¶ "He who strikes his father or his mother shall surely be put to death.

Ex. 21:17 ¶ "He who curses his father or his mother shall surely be put to death.

<u>Deut. 21:18-21</u> 18 ¶ "If any man has a stubborn and rebellious son who will not obey his father or his mother, and when they chastise him, he will not even listen to them, <u>19</u> then his father and mother shall seize him, and bring him out to the elders of his city at the gateway of his hometown. <u>20</u> "They shall say to the elders of his city, 'This son of ours is stubborn and rebellious, he will not obey us, he is a glutton and a drunkard.' <u>21</u> "Then all the men of his city shall stone him to death; so you shall remove the evil from your midst, and all Israel will hear *of it* and fear.

Deut. 27:16 ¶ 'Cursed is he who dishonors his father or mother.' And all the people shall say, 'Amen.'

<u>Matt. 15:4-6</u> <u>4</u> "For God said, 'HONOR YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER,' and, 'HE WHO SPEAKS EVIL OF FATHER OR MOTHER IS TO BE PUT TO DEATH.' <u>5</u> "But you say, 'Whoever says to *his* father or mother, "Whatever I have that would help you has been given *to God*," <u>6</u> he is not to honor his father or his mother.' And *by this* you invalidated the word of God for the sake of your tradition.

<u>1 John 1:9</u> If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Eph. 4:32 Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

<u>Col. 3:13</u> bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you.
