<u>Deut. 4:9, 10 9</u> "Only give heed to yourself and keep your soul diligently, so that you do not forget the things which your eyes have seen and they do not depart from your heart all the days of your life; but make them known to your sons and your grandsons. <u>10</u> "Remember the day you stood before the LORD your God at Horeb, when the LORD said to me, 'Assemble the people to Me, that I may let them hear My words so they may learn to fear Me all the days they live on the earth, and that they may teach their children.'

<u>Deut. 31:12</u> "Assemble the people, the men and **the women and children** and the alien who is in your town, so that they may hear and learn **and fear the LORD your God**, and be careful to observe all the words of this law.

<u>Deut. 27:10</u> "You shall therefore **obey the LORD your God**, and do His commandments and His statutes which I command you today."

<u>Col. 3:20</u> Children, **be obedient to your parents** in all things, for this is well-pleasing to the Lord.

<u>1 Pet. 2:13, 14</u> <u>13</u> ¶ Submit yourselves for the Lord's sake to every human institution, whether to a king as the one in authority, <u>14</u> or to governors as sent by him for the punishment of evildoers and the praise of those who do right.

Rom. 6:23a For the **wages of sin is death**, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

- **2 Pet. 3:9** The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, **not wishing for any to perish** but for all to come to repentance.
- **2 Kings 2:23, 24 23** ¶ Then he went up from there to Bethel; and as he was going up by the way, **young lads** came out from the city **and mocked him** and said to him, "Go up, you baldhead; go up, you baldhead!" **24** When he looked behind him and saw them, he cursed them in the name of the LORD. **Then two female bears came out of the woods and tore up forty-two lads** of their number.
- Rev. 20:14, 15 14 Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. 15 And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

- <u>John 3:16</u> ¶ "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.
- Matt. 19:13, 14 13 ¶ Then some children were brought to Him so that He might lay His hands on them and pray; and the disciples rebuked them. 14 But Jesus said, "Let the children alone, and do not hinder them from coming to Me; for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these."
- <u>2 Tim. 1:5</u> For I am mindful of the **sincere faith within you**, which **first dwelt in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice**, and I am sure that *it is* in you as well.
- <u>2 Tim. 3:15</u> and that **from childhood** you have known the sacred writings which are able to give you the wisdom that leads to salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.
- **Eph. 6:4** ¶ **Fathers,** do not provoke your children to anger, but **bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.**

- <u>Dan. 1:1-6, 8-21</u> ¶ In the third year of the reign of Jehoiakim king of Judah, Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came to Jerusalem and besieged it.
- <u>Dan. 1:2</u> The Lord gave Jehoiakim king of Judah into his hand, along with some of the vessels of the house of God; and he brought them to the land of Shinar, to the house of his god, and he brought the vessels into the treasury of his god.
- **<u>Dan. 1:3</u>** ¶ Then the king ordered Ashpenaz, the chief of his officials, to bring in some of the sons of Israel, including some of the royal family and of the nobles,
- **Dan. 1:4** youths in whom was no defect, who were good-looking, showing intelligence in every *branch of* wisdom, endowed with understanding and discerning knowledge, and who had ability for serving in the king's court; and *he ordered him* to teach them the literature and language of the Chaldeans.
- <u>Dan. 1:5</u> The king appointed for them a daily ration from the king's choice food and from the wine which he drank, and *appointed* that they should be educated three years, at the end of which they were to enter the king's personal service.
- <u>Dan. 1:6</u> Now among them from the sons of Judah were **Daniel**, **Hananiah**, **Mishael** and **Azariah**.

- <u>Dan. 1:8</u> ¶ But Daniel made up his mind that he would not defile himself with the king's choice food or with the wine which he drank; so he sought *permission* from the commander of the officials that he might not defile himself.
- <u>Dan. 1:9</u> Now God granted Daniel favor and compassion in the sight of the commander of the officials,
- **Dan. 1:10** and the commander of the officials said to Daniel, "I am afraid of my lord the king, who has appointed your food and your drink; for why should he see your faces looking more haggard than the youths who are your own age? Then you would make me forfeit my head to the king."
- **Dan. 1:11** But Daniel said to the overseer whom the commander of the officials had appointed over Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael and Azariah,
- <u>Dan. 1:12</u> "Please test your servants for ten days, and let us be given some vegetables to eat and water to drink.
- <u>Dan. 1:13</u> "Then let our appearance be observed in your presence and the appearance of the youths who are eating the king's choice food; and **deal with your servants** according to what you see."
- **Dan. 1:14** ¶ So he listened to them in this matter and tested them for ten days.
- <u>Dan. 1:15</u> At the end of ten days their appearance seemed better and they were fatter than all the youths who had been eating the king's choice food.
- <u>Dan. 1:16</u> So the overseer continued to withhold their choice food and the wine they were to drink, and kept giving them vegetables.
- <u>Dan. 1:17</u> ¶ As for these four youths, God gave them knowledge and intelligence in every *branch of* literature and wisdom; Daniel even understood all *kinds of* visions and dreams.
- <u>Dan. 1:18</u> ¶ Then at the end of the days which the king had specified for presenting them, the commander of the officials **presented them before Nebuchadnezzar.**
- <u>Dan. 1:19</u> The king talked with them, and out of them all **not one was found like** <u>Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael and Azariah</u>; so they entered the king's personal service.
- <u>Dan. 1:20</u> As for every matter of wisdom and understanding about which the king consulted them, he found them **ten times better** than all the magicians *and* conjurers who *were* in all his realm.

Dan. 1:21 And **Daniel continued until the first year of Cyrus** the king.

- <u>1 Pet. 5:8</u> Be of sober *spirit*, be on the alert. **Your adversary, the devil**, prowls around like a roaring lion, **seeking someone to devour.**
- Rom. 8:13, 14 13 for if you are living according to the flesh, you must die; but **if by** the Spirit you are putting to death the deeds of the body, you will live. 14 For all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.
- Rom. 8:16, 17 16 The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God, 17 and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with *Him* so that we may also be glorified with *Him*.
- <u>1 John 3:1-3</u> ¶ See how great a love the Father has bestowed on us, **that we would be called children of God; and** *such* **we are.** For this reason the world does not know us, because it did not know Him. <u>2</u> Beloved, **now we are children of God**, and it has not appeared as yet what we will be. We know that when He appears, **we will be like Him**, because we will see Him just as He is. <u>3</u> And everyone who has **this hope** *fixed* **on Him purifies himself**, just as He is pure.
- Mark 12:30 AND YOU SHALL LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND, AND WITH ALL YOUR STRENGTH.'
- <u>1 Pet. 1:14, 15</u> <u>14</u> As obedient children, do not be conformed to the former lusts which were yours in your ignorance, <u>15</u> but like the Holy One who called you, **be holy yourselves** also **in all** *your* **behavior**;
- <u>Rom. 12:2</u> And **do not be conformed to this world**, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.
- <u>1 John 2:15-17</u> <u>15</u> ¶ Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. <u>16</u> For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world. <u>17</u> The world is passing away, and *also* its lusts; but the one who does the will of God lives forever.
