Sunday, July 3, 2022 Sermon Scriptures

<u>Matt. 14:14</u> When He went ashore, He saw a large crowd, and felt compassion for them and healed their sick.

<u>Mark 6:30</u> ¶ The apostles gathered together with Jesus; and they reported to Him all that they had done and taught.

<u>Luke 9:10</u> ¶ When the apostles returned, they gave an account to Him of all that they had done. Taking them with Him, He withdrew by Himself to a city called Bethsaida.

Mark 6:31, 32 31 And He said to them, "Come away by yourselves to a secluded place and rest a while." (For there were many *people* coming and going, and they did not even have time to eat.) 32 They went away in the boat to a secluded place by themselves.

<u>Mark 6:33</u> The people saw them going, and many recognized them and ran there together on foot from all the cities, and got there ahead of them.

<u>Mark 6:34</u> When Jesus went ashore, He saw a large crowd, and He felt compassion for them because they were like sheep without a shepherd; and He began to teach them many things.

<u>Matt. 14:14</u> When He went ashore, He saw a large crowd, and felt compassion for them and healed their sick.

<u>Luke 9:11</u> But the crowds were aware of this and followed Him; and welcoming them, He *began* speaking to them about the kingdom of God and curing those who had need of healing.

Matt. 14:15 ¶ When it was evening, the disciples came to Him and said, "This place is desolate and the hour is already late; so send the crowds away, that they may go into the villages and buy food for themselves."

<u>Luke 9:12</u> ¶ Now the day was ending, and the twelve came and said to Him, "Send the crowd away, that they may go into the surrounding villages and countryside and find lodging and get something to eat; for here we are in a desolate place."

Mark 6:37 But He answered them, "You give them *something* to eat!" And they said to Him, "Shall we go and spend two hundred denarii on bread and give them *something* to eat?"

<u>John 6:5-7</u> Therefore Jesus, lifting up His eyes and seeing that a large crowd was coming to Him, said to Philip, "Where are we to buy bread, so that these may eat?" <u>6</u> This He was saying to test him, for He Himself knew what He was intending to do.

<u>7</u> Philip answered Him, "Two hundred denarii worth of bread is not sufficient for them, for everyone to receive a little."

<u>John 14:26</u> "But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you.

Mark 6:38 And He said to them, "How many loaves do you have? Go look!" And when they found out, they said, "Five, and two fish."

<u>John 6:8, 9</u> 8 One of His disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, said to Him, <u>9</u> "There is a lad here who has five barley loaves and two fish, but what are these for so many people?"

<u>Luke 9:14</u> (For there were about five thousand men.) And He said to His disciples, "Have them sit down *to eat* in groups of about fifty each."

Mark 6:39, 40 39 And He commanded them all to sit down by groups on the green grass. 40 They sat down in groups of hundreds and of fifties.

<u>John 6:10</u> Jesus said, "Have the people sit down." Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, in number about five thousand.

<u>Matt. 14:19</u> Ordering the people to sit down on the grass, He took the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up toward heaven, He blessed *the food*, and breaking the loaves He gave them to the disciples, and the disciples *gave them* to the crowds,

<u>Mark 6:41</u> And He took the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up toward heaven, He blessed *the food* and broke the loaves and He kept giving *them* to the disciples to set before them; and He divided up the two fish among them all.

<u>John 6:11</u> Jesus then took the loaves, and having given thanks, He distributed to those who were seated; likewise also of the fish as much as they wanted.

Mark 6:42 They all ate and were satisfied,

<u>John 6:12</u> When they were filled, He said to His disciples, "Gather up the leftover fragments so that nothing will be lost."

Mark 6:43, 44 and they picked up twelve full baskets of the broken pieces, and also of the fish. 44 There were five thousand men who ate the loaves.

Matt. 14:21 There were about five thousand men who ate, besides women and children.

<u>John 6:14, 15a</u> 14 Therefore when the people saw the sign which He had performed, they said, "This is truly the Prophet who is to come into the world."

15a ¶ So Jesus, perceiving that they were intending to come and take Him by force to make Him king, withdrew again to the mountain by Himself alone.

Matt. 14:22 ¶ Immediately He made the disciples get into the boat and go ahead of Him to the other side, while He sent the crowds away.

<u>Mark 6:45</u> ¶ Immediately Jesus made His disciples get into the boat and go ahead of Him to the other side to Bethsaida, while He Himself was sending the crowd away.

Mark 6:46 After bidding them farewell, He left for the mountain to pray.
