Thyatira (Qua¿teira *Thyateira*). A city in the Lycus River valley in western Asia Minor, in the territory of the ancient kingdom of Lydia. Thyatira was located about halfway between Pergamum to the northwest and Sardis to the southeast, often finding itself embroiled in conflicts between the Pergamene and Seleucid kings. It eventually came under the control of Pergamum, and subsequently, the Romans, who posted a garrison there.

Thyatira was a city known for various trades. Inscriptional evidence mentions trade guilds for those working in wool, leather, bronze, and the manufacture of armor. Most notably, the people of Thyatira learned how to make purple dye from the madder root which grew locally. Acts 16:14 describes the woman Lydia, whom Paul evangelized in Philippi, as a dealer in purple cloth from the city of Thyatira.
