<u>**Rev. 2:18</u>** ¶ "And to the angel of the church in Thyatira write: ¶ The Son of God, who has eyes like a flame of fire, and His feet are like burnished bronze, says this:</u>

<u>John 1:1</u> ¶ In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

<u>**Rev. 2:8**</u> ¶ "And to the angel of the church in Smyrna write: ¶ **The first and the last**, who was dead, and has come to life, says this:

<u>Is. 44:6</u> "Thus says **the LORD**, the King of Israel and **his Redeemer**, the LORD of hosts: **'I am the first and I am the last**, And there is **no God besides Me**.

<u>Rev. 1:14</u> His head and His hair were white like white wool, like snow; and **His eyes were like a flame of fire.**

<u>Rev. 1:15</u> His **feet** *were* **like burnished bronze**, when it has been made to glow in a furnace, and His voice *was* like the sound of many waters.

<u>Rev. 2:19</u> ¶ 'I know **your deeds,** and your **love** and **faith** and **service** and **perseverance**, and that your **deeds of late** are **greater** than at first.

Eph. 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus **for good works**, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.

<u>Titus 2:14</u> who gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, **zealous for good deeds**.

<u>Titus 3:8</u> This is a trustworthy statement; and concerning these things I want you to speak confidently, so that those who **have believed God will be careful to engage in good deeds.** These things are good and profitable for men.

<u>Titus 3:14</u> Our people **must also learn to engage in good deeds** to meet pressing needs, so that they **will not be unfruitful.**

<u>Heb. 10:24</u> and let us consider how to **stimulate one another** to love and **good deeds**,

<u>Rev. 2:20</u> 'But I have *this* against you, that **you tolerate the woman Jezebel**, who **calls herself a prophetess**, and she **teaches and leads** My **bond**-**servants astray** so that they **commit** *acts of* **immorality** and eat things **sacrificed to idols**.

1 Kings 21:25, 2625 \P Surely there was no one like Ahab who soldhimself to do evil in the sight of the LORD, because Jezebel his wifeincited him.26He acted very abominably in following idols, according toall that the Amorites had done, whom the LORD cast out before the sons ofIsrael.

<u>**1 Kings 16:31-33 31</u>** ¶ It came about, **as though it had been a trivial thing for him** to walk in the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, that he married Jezebel the daughter of Ethbaal king of the Sidonians, **and went to serve Baal and worshiped him**. <u>**32**</u> So he erected an altar for Baal in the house of Baal which he built in Samaria. <u>**33**</u> Ahab also made the Asherah. Thus Ahab did more to provoke the LORD God of Israel than all the kings of Israel who were before him.</u>

<u>Acts 15:19, 20</u> 19 ¶ "Therefore it is my judgment that we do not trouble **those who are turning to God from among the Gentiles**, <u>20</u> but that we write to them that they **abstain from** things **contaminated by idols** and **from fornication** and from what is strangled and from blood.

<u>Acts 15:28, 29</u> <u>28</u> "For it seemed good to the Holy Spirit and to us to lay upon you no greater burden than these essentials: <u>29</u> that you abstain from things sacrificed to idols and from blood and from things strangled and from fornication; if you keep yourselves free from such things, you will do well. Farewell."

<u>**Rev. 2:21</u>** 'I gave her time to repent, and she does not want to repent of her immorality.</u>

<u>Rev. 2:22</u> 'Behold, I will throw her on a bed *of sickness*, and those who commit adultery with her into great tribulation, unless they repent of her deeds.

<u>Rev. 2:23</u> 'And I will kill her children with pestilence, and all the churches will know that I am He who searches the minds and hearts; and I will give to each one of you according to your deeds.

<u>**Rev. 2:24</u>** 'But I say to you, **the rest who are in Thyatira, who do not hold this teaching,** who have not known the deep things of Satan, as they call them — I place no other burden on you.</u>

<u>Rev. 2:25</u> 'Nevertheless what you have, hold fast until I come.

<u>**Rev. 2:26</u>** 'He who overcomes, and he who keeps My deeds until the end, TO HIM I WILL GIVE AUTHORITY OVER THE NATIONS;</u>

<u>Rev. 2:27</u> AND HE SHALL RULE THEM WITH A ROD OF IRON, AS THE VESSELS OF THE POTTER ARE BROKEN TO PIECES, as I also have received *authority* from My Father;

<u>Rev. 2:28</u> and I will give him the morning star.

<u>Rev. 22:16</u> ¶ "I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things for the churches. I am the root and the descendant of David, the bright **morning** star."

<u>Rev. 2:29</u> 'He who has an ear, **let him hear what the Spirit says** to the churches.'
