- c. Ultimate, God will Perfect us one day, Eph. 5:26-27
- 2. God's instrument for our Growing is His Word, Jn. 17:17b
- Peter tells new believers to desire God's Word, 1 Pet. 2:2

## III. GOD DESIGNED HIS WORD AS HIS GROWTH INSTRUMENT FOR HIS PEOPLE

- A. The Lord Told His Disciples To Teach His Word To Those He Saves From The Gentiles, Mt. 28:20
- B. God Told His Preachers To Preach And Teach His Word, To His People, 2 Tim. 2:15; 4:2-4
- C. Believers Are To Love God And His Word,
  - 1. God has told us to love Him with our full being, Mk. 12:30
  - 2. Love of God's Word will help us cultivate a love for Him, Psa. 119:9, 11, 18, 97, 105
    --(longest 176)

3. We should seize every opportunity to grow by God's Word. (behavior)
--S. S., Morning Service, Sunday Evenings, Wednesday Evening, Etc.

## IV. STAYING IN FELLOWSHIP WITH GOD PLEASES

- HIM, 1 Thess. 4:1; Jn. 15:9, 10 --Sin always breaks fellowship with God.
  - A. Genuine Believers Do Sin, 1 Jn. 1:8 --We see it in the N. T. in many forms,
    - --God wants us to strive not to sin, 1 Jn. 2:1
  - B. Genuine Believers Repent Of Their Sins Before God, 1 Jn. 1:9 They will experience the guilt and sorry

--They will experience the guilt and sorrow for their sin.

- C. Genuine Believers Must Always Remember They Are In A Race Of Life, Heb. 12:1,2
- D. Genuine Believers Must Always Remember That God Is Always Ready To Help Them In The Battle With Sin.
  - 1. He warns them to be on the alert for the devil, 1 Pet. 5:8
  - 2. He reminds them of His help in temptations, 1 Cor. 10:13 "way of escape"
  - 3. He reminds them to use tools He provides in the battle with sin, Rom. 6:11-13 --Resolute Will.
