<u>Rom. 8:1</u> ¶ Therefore there is now **no condemnation for those who are in Christ** Jesus.

**Eph. 2:1-3 1** ¶ And you were **dead in your trespasses and sins**, **2** in which you **formerly walked** according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience. **3** Among them we too all **formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh**, indulging the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and **were by nature children of wrath**, even as the rest.

Gal. 5:19-2119Now the deeds of the flesh are evident, which are: immorality,<br/>impurity, sensuality,20idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger,<br/>disputes, dissensions, factions,21envying, drunkenness, carousing, and things like<br/>these, of which I forewarn you, just as I have forewarned you, that those who practice<br/>such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

<u>Gal. 5:22, 23</u> 22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <u>23</u> gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

John 17:17 "Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth.

<u>Jude 1</u> ¶ Jude, a bond-servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, ¶ To those who are **the called**, beloved in God the Father, and **kept for Jesus Christ**:

<u>**2** Thess. 2:13</u>  $\P$  But we should always give thanks to God for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because **God has chosen you from the beginning** for salvation through **sanctification** by the Spirit and faith in the truth.

**<u>Eph. 5:1</u>** ¶ Therefore **be imitators of God**, as beloved children;

<u>**Rom. 13:14</u>** But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and **make no provision for the flesh in regard to** *its* **lusts.**</u>

<u>2 Tim. 2:15</u> Be diligent to present yourself **approved to God** as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, **accurately handling the word of truth.** 

<u>2 Tim. 4:2-4</u> <u>2</u> preach the word; be ready in season *and* out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction. <u>3</u> For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but *wanting* to have their ears tickled, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance to their own desires, <u>4</u> and will turn away their ears from the truth and will turn aside to myths.

<u>Mark 12:30</u> AND YOU SHALL LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND, AND WITH ALL YOUR STRENGTH.'

**<u>Psa. 119:9</u>**  $\P$  How can a **young man keep his way pure?** By keeping *it* according **to Your word.** 

<u>Psa. 119:11</u> Your word I have treasured in my heart, That I may not sin against You.

Psa. 119:18 Open my eyes, that I may behold Wonderful things from Your law.

**<u>Psa. 119:97</u> O how I love Your law!** It is my meditation all the day.

**<u>Psa. 119:105</u>** ¶ Your word is a **lamp to my feet** And a **light to my path**.

<u>1 Thess. 4:1</u> ¶ Finally then, brethren, we request and exhort you in the Lord Jesus, that as you received from us *instruction* as to **how you ought to walk and please God** (just as you actually do walk), **that you excel still more.** 

<u>John 15:9, 10</u> "Just as the Father has loved Me, I have also loved you; **abide in** <u>My love.</u> <u>10</u> "If you **keep My commandments, you will abide in My love**; just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.

**<u>1 John 1:8</u>** If we say that **we have no sin, we are deceiving ourselves** and the truth is not in us.

<u>**1** John 2:1</u> ¶ My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous;

<u>**1** John 1:9</u> If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

<u>Heb. 12:1, 2</u> 1 Therefore, since we have so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us also lay aside every encumbrance and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,

<u>Heb. 12:2</u> fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

<u>**1** Pet. 5:8</u> Be of sober *spirit*, **be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil**, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.

<u>1 Cor. 10:13</u> No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, so that you will be able to endure it.

Rom. 6:11-1311Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in<br/>Christ Jesus.12Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you<br/>obey its lusts,13and do not go on presenting the members of your body to<br/>sin as instruments of unrighteousness; but present yourselves to God as those alive<br/>from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.
