<u>1 Thess. 4:1</u> ¶ Finally then, brethren, we request and exhort you in the Lord Jesus, that as you received from us *instruction* as to **how you ought to walk and please God** (just as you actually do walk), **that you excel still more.**

<u>John 15:9, 10</u> "Just as the Father has loved Me, I have also loved you; **abide in My** love. <u>10</u> "If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love; just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.

<u>1 John 1:8</u> If we say that **we have no sin, we are deceiving ourselves** and the truth is not in us.

1 Cor. 6:18-2018Flee immorality. Every *other* sin that a man commits is outsidethe body, but the immoral man sins against his own body.19Or do you not know thatyour body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, andthat you are not your own?20glorify God in your body.20For you have been bought with a price: therefore

<u>Gal. 3:1</u> ¶ You foolish Galatians, who has bewitched you, before whose eyes Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed *as* crucified?

<u>1 John 2:1</u> ¶ My little children, I am writing these things to you **so that you may not sin.** And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous;

<u>Prov. 28:13</u> He who conceals his transgressions will not prosper, But he who confesses and forsakes *them* will find compassion.

<u>**Rev. 3:19**</u> 'Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline; therefore be zealous and repent.

<u>**1** Cor. 15:34</u> Become sober-minded as you ought, and **stop sinning**; for some have no knowledge of God. I speak *this* to your shame.

<u>**1** John 1:9</u> If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

<u>Gal. 6:1</u> ¶ Brethren, even if anyone is caught in any trespass, you who are spiritual, restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness; *each one* looking to yourself, so that you too will not be tempted.

<u>**2** Cor. 7:10</u> For the sorrow that is according to *the will of* God produces a repentance without regret, *leading* to salvation, but the sorrow of the world produces death.

<u>Heb. 12:1, 2</u> 1 Therefore, since we have so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us also **lay aside every encumbrance** and **the sin which so easily entangles** us, and let us run with endurance **the race that is set before us**, <u>2</u> fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

<u>**1** Cor. 9:24-27</u> <u>24</u> ¶ Do you not know that **those who run in a race** all run, but *only* one receives the prize? **Run in such a way that you may win**. <u>25</u> Everyone who competes in the games **exercises self-control** in all things. They then *do it* to receive a perishable wreath, but we an imperishable. <u>26</u> Therefore **I run in such a way**, as not without aim; I box in such a way, as not beating the air; <u>27</u> but **I discipline my body and make it my slave**, so that, after I have preached to others, I myself will not be disqualified.

<u>**1** Pet. 5:8</u> Be of sober *spirit*, **be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil**, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.

<u>1 Cor. 10:13</u> No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, so that you will be able to endure it.

Rom. 6:11-1311Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in
Christ Jesus.12 ¶ Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you
obey its lusts,12 ¶ Therefore do not go on presenting the members of your body to
sin as instruments of unrighteousness; but present yourselves to God as those alive
from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.

<u>**Gal. 5:24</u>** Now those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.</u>
