Matt. 14:22 ¶ Immediately He made the disciples get into the boat and go ahead of Him to the other side, while He sent the crowds away.

<u>Mark 6:45</u> ¶ Immediately Jesus made His disciples get into the boat and go ahead of Him to the other side to Bethsaida, while He Himself was sending the crowd away.

Mark 6:46 After bidding them farewell, He left for the mountain to pray.

Matt. 14:24 But the boat was already a long distance from the land, battered by the waves; for the wind was contrary.

**John 6:18** The sea *began* to be stirred up because a strong wind was blowing.

Mark 6:47 \ When it was evening, the boat was in the middle of the sea, and He was alone on the land.

<u>John 6:19</u> Then, when they had rowed about three or four miles, they saw Jesus walking on the sea and drawing near to the boat; and they were frightened.

<u>Mark 6:48</u> Seeing them straining at the oars, for the wind was against them, at about the fourth watch of the night He came to them, walking on the sea; and He intended to pass by them.

<u>Matt. 14:26</u> When the disciples saw Him walking on the sea, they were terrified, and said, "It is a ghost!" And they cried out in fear.

<u>Mark 6:50</u> for they all saw Him and were terrified. But immediately He spoke with them and said to them, "Take courage; it is I, do not be afraid."

Matt. 14:27 But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, "Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid."

Matt. 14:28, 29 28 ¶ Peter said to Him, "Lord, if it is You, command me to come to You on the water." 29 And He said, "Come!" And Peter got out of the boat, and walked on the water and came toward Jesus.

Matt. 14:30 But seeing the wind, he became frightened, and beginning to sink, he cried out, "Lord, save me!"

<u>Matt. 14:31</u> Immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and took hold of him, and said to him, "You of little faith, why did you doubt?"

Matt. 14:32 When they got into the boat, the wind stopped.

Mark 6:51, 52 51 Then He got into the boat with them, and the wind stopped; and they were utterly astonished, 52 for they had not gained any insight from the *incident* of the loaves, but their heart was hardened.

Matt. 14:33 And those who were in the boat worshiped Him, saying, "You are certainly God's Son!"

<u>John 6:21</u> So they were willing to receive Him into the boat, and immediately the boat was at the land to which they were going.

<u>Mark 6:53</u> ¶ When they had crossed over they came to land at Gennesaret, and moored to the shore.

Mark 6:54 When they got out of the boat, immediately the people recognized Him,

<u>Mark 6:55</u> and ran about that whole country and began to carry here and there on their pallets those who were sick, to the place they heard He was.

<u>Matt. 14:35</u> And when the men of that place recognized Him, they sent *word* into all that surrounding district and brought to Him all who were sick;

Matt. 14:36 and they implored Him that they might just touch the fringe of His cloak; and as many as touched *it* were cured.

<u>Mark 6:56</u> Wherever He entered villages, or cities, or countryside, they were laying the sick in the market places, and imploring Him that they might just touch the fringe of His cloak; and as many as touched it were being cured.
