Capernaum A town on the northwest shore of the Sea of Galilee, Capernaum was a Roman garrison town under the jurisdiction of a centurion. The centurion who was there at the time of Jesus had built the town synagogue (Luke 7:2-5). Capernaum was the home of Peter and Andrew (Mark 1:21, 29), and a central location for Jesus' ministry—so much so that he was apparently considered a resident of the city (Matthew 4:13; 9:1; Mark 2:1). Capernaum was also the setting for the calling of Matthew (Matthew 9:9-13; Mark 2:13-17; Luke 5:27-32), the sermon on the Bread of Life (John 6:24-59), the miracle of the gold from the fish's mouth (Matthew 17:24-27), and Jesus' lesson on the first and the last (Mark 9:33-37). Capernaum was among the Galilean towns which Jesus condemned for their unbelief (Matthew 11:23-24; Luke 10:15).
