IV. THE UNBELIEVING JEWS BEGAN TO ARGUE OVER WHAT THE LORD SAID, v-52-59

A. They Question How The Lord Could Give Them
His Flesh To Eat, v-52

B. The Lord Began To Push His Point Even More,
v-53-59

1. He told them that if they didn't eat His flesh
and drink His blood they had no chance for
Eternal Life, v-53
2. He who eats His flesh and drinks His blood
has Eternal Life and he will be resurrected to
glory, v-54
3. He explained that His flesh was true food
and His blood was true drink, v-55
4. He who eats His flesh and drinks His blood
has an abiding relationship with Him, v-56
5. Also a living relationship exists between
God the Father, and Christ and the one who
eats His flesh, v-57
6. This Bread from Heaven is a different kind
of bread than that Israel's fathers ate, and
has a different result, v-58

a. They died after eating the manna

b. They who eat His bread will live
forever
