<u>Acts 26:15-18</u> <u>15</u> "And I said, 'Who are You, Lord?' And the Lord said, 'I am Jesus whom you are persecuting. <u>16</u> 'But get up and stand on your feet; for this purpose I have appeared to you, to appoint you a minister and a witness not only to the things which you have seen, but also to the things in which I will appear to you; <u>17</u> rescuing you from the *Jewish* people and from the Gentiles, to whom I am sending you, <u>18</u> to open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.'

<u>**2** Cor. 5:6-9</u> <u>6</u> Therefore, being always of good courage, and knowing that while we are **at home in the body we are absent from the Lord** <u>7</u> for we walk by faith, not by sight <u>8</u> we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather to be absent from the body **and to be at home with the Lord**. <u>9</u> Therefore we also have as our ambition, whether at home or absent, **to be pleasing to Him**.

**<u>Rom. 9:23</u>** And *He did so* to make known the riches of His glory upon vessels of mercy, which **He prepared beforehand for glory**,

<u>Col. 3:4</u> When Christ, who is our life, is revealed, then you also will be revealed with Him in glory.

<u>**Rom. 8:18</u>** ¶ For I consider that the sufferings of this **present time are not worthy to be** compared with the glory that is to be revealed to us.</u>

<u>2 Cor. 4:17</u> For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison,

**Isa. 9:7** There will be no end to the increase of *His* government or of peace, On the throne of David and over his kingdom, To establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness From then on and forevermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will accomplish this.

**Dan. 7:27** 'Then the sovereignty, the dominion and the greatness of *all* the kingdoms under the whole heaven will be given to the people of the saints of the Highest One; His kingdom *will be* an everlasting kingdom, and all the dominions will serve and obey Him.'

**<u>Rev. 5:9</u>** And they sang a new song, saying, "Worthy are You to take the book and to break its seals; for You were slain, and purchased for God with Your blood *men* from every tribe and tongue and people and nation.

<u>Matt. 24:30, 31</u> <u>30</u> "And then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in the sky, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the SON OF MAN COMING ON THE CLOUDS OF THE SKY with power and great glory. <u>31</u> "And He will send forth His angels with A GREAT TRUMPET and THEY WILL GATHER TOGETHER His elect from the four winds, from one end of the sky to the other.

<u>Matt. 6:10</u> 'Your kingdom come. Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven.

**<u>2 Tim. 2:12</u>** If we endure, **we will also reign with Him**; If we deny Him, He also will deny us;

**<u>Rev. 20:4-6</u> (**] Then **I** saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them. And I *saw* the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received the mark on their forehead and on their hand; and they came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. <u>5</u> The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were completed. This is the first resurrection. <u>6</u> Blessed and holy is the one who has a part in the first resurrection; over these the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years.

<u>2 Pet. 3:13</u> But according to His promise we are looking for new heavens and a new earth, in which righteousness dwells.

**<u>Rev. 21:1</u>** ¶ Then **I saw a new heaven and a new earth**; for the first heaven and the first earth passed away, and there is no longer *any* sea.

<u>**Rev. 21:2</u>** And **I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem**, coming down out of heaven from God, made ready as a bride adorned for her husband.</u>

**<u>Rev. 21:3-5</u>** And I heard a loud voice from the throne, saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is among men, and He will dwell among them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself will be among them, <u>4</u> and **He will wipe away every tear** from their eyes; and there will **no longer be** *any* **death**; there will **no longer be** *any* **mourning, or crying, or pain;** the first things have passed away."

**<u>Rev. 21:5</u>** ¶ And He who sits on the throne said, "Behold, **I am making all things new**." And He said, "Write, for these words are faithful and true."

**<u>Rev. 22:3-5</u>** There will **no longer be any curse**; and the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in it, and His bond-servants will serve Him; <u>4</u> they will see His face, and His name *will be* on their foreheads. <u>5</u> And there will no longer be *any* night; and they will not have need of the light of a lamp nor the light of the sun, because the Lord God will illumine them; and they will reign forever and ever.

**<u>Eph. 4:1</u>** ¶ Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to **walk in a manner worthy of the calling** with which you have been called,

<u>Col. 1:10</u> so that you will **walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, to please** *Him* in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;

**<u>1 Thess. 2:12</u>** so that you would **walk in a manner worthy of the God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory.**

<u>**1** Pet. 1:15</u> but like the Holy One who called you, **be holy yourselves also in all** *your* **behavior;**

<u>John 13:34, 35</u> <u>34</u> "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another. <u>35</u> "By this all men will know that you are My disciples, **if you have love for one another**."

**<u>Rom. 12:10</u>** *Be* devoted to one another in brotherly love; give preference to one another in honor;

<u>Eph. 4:2</u> with all humility and gentleness, with patience, showing tolerance for one another in love,

<u>2 Thess. 1:3</u> ¶ We ought always to give thanks to God for you, brethren, as is *only* fitting, because your faith is greatly enlarged, and the love of each one of you toward one another grows *ever* greater;

Heb. 10:24 and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds,

<u>**1** Pet. 4:8</u> Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins.

<u>Eph. 4:32</u> Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

<u>Col. 3:13</u> bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you.

<u>Col. 3:17</u> Whatever you do in word or deed, *do* all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father.

**<u>1 Thess. 5:18</u>** in everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

<u>Heb. 13:15</u> Through Him then, let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that give thanks to His name.
