Sunday, December 11, 2022 Sermon Scriptures

<u>Gen. 1:27</u> God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

<u>Gen. 1:31</u> God saw all that He had made, and behold, it was very good. And there was evening and there was morning, the sixth day.

<u>**Gen. 2:18</u>** ¶ Then the LORD God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone; I will make him a helper suitable for him."</u>

<u>Gen. 2:21-23</u> 21 So the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon the man, and he slept; then He took one of his ribs and closed up the flesh at that place. 22 The LORD God fashioned into a woman the rib which He had taken from the man, and brought her to the man. 23 The man said, "This is now bone of my bones, And flesh of my flesh; She shall be called Woman, Because she was taken out of Man."

Gen. 1:28 God blessed them; and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it; and rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

<u>Gen. 2:24</u> For this reason a man shall leave his father and his mother, and be joined to his wife; and they shall become one flesh.

<u>Rom. 1:18</u>-20 18 ¶ For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, **<u>19</u>** because that which is known about God is evident within them; for God made it evident to them. **<u>20</u>** For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse.

Rom. 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

<u>Matt. 19:3</u>-6 3 ¶ Some Pharisees came to Jesus, testing Him and asking, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for any reason at all?" <u>4</u> And He answered and said, "Have you not read that He who created *them* from the beginning MADE THEM MALE AND FEMALE, <u>5</u> and said, 'FOR THIS REASON A MAN SHALL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND MOTHER AND BE JOINED TO HIS WIFE, AND THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH'? <u>6</u> "So they are no longer two, but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let no man separate."

Eph. 5:22-24 22 ¶ Wives, be subject to your own husbands, as to the Lord. 23 For the husband is the head of the wife, as Christ also is the head of the church, He Himself being the Savior of the body. 24 But as the church is subject to Christ, so also the wives ought to be to their husbands in everything.

Col. 3:18 ¶ Wives, be subject to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord.

<u>1 Pet. 3:1-6</u> 1 In the same way, you wives, be submissive to your own husbands so that even if any *of them* are disobedient to the word, they may be won without a word by the behavior of their wives, **<u>2</u>** as they observe your chaste and respectful behavior. **<u>3</u>** Your adornment must not be *merely* external — braiding the hair, and wearing gold jewelry, or putting on dresses; **<u>4</u>** but *let it be* the hidden person of the heart, with the imperishable quality of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is precious in the sight of God. **<u>5</u>** For in this way in former times the holy women also, who hoped in God, used to adorn themselves, being submissive to their own husbands; **<u>6</u>** just as Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord, and you have become her children if you do what is right without being frightened by any fear.

Eph. 5:33b Nevertheless, each individual among you also is to love his own wife even as himself, and **the wife must** *see to it* **that she respects her husband**.

<u>**Rom. 6:6**</u> knowing this, that **our old self was crucified with** *Him*, in order that our body of sin might be done away with, so that **we would no longer be slaves to sin**;

Eph. 4:24 and **put on the new self**, which in *the likeness of* God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth.

<u>Eph. 5:25</u> ¶ **Husbands**, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her,

Eph. 5:28-30 28 So husbands ought also to love their own wives as their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself; **29** for no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ also *does* the church, **30** because we are members of His body.

<u>Eph. 5:33a</u> Nevertheless, each individual among you also is to love his own wife even as himself, and the wife must *see to it* that she respects her husband.

<u>Col. 3:19</u> Husbands, love your wives and do not be embittered against them.

<u>**1** Pet. 3:7</u> ¶ You husbands in the same way, live with *your wives* in an understanding way, as with someone weaker, since she is a woman; and show her honor as a fellow heir of the grace of life, so that your prayers will not be hindered.

<u>Eph. 4:22</u> that, in reference to your former manner of life, you **lay aside the old self**, which is being corrupted in accordance with the lusts of deceit,

<u>Rom. 13:14</u> But **put on the Lord Jesus Christ**, and make no provision for the flesh in regard to *its* lusts.

<u>Titus 2:4, 5</u> <u>4</u> so that they may encourage the **young women to love their husbands**, **to love their children**, <u>5</u> *to be* sensible, pure, workers at home, kind, being subject to their own husbands, so that the word of God will not be dishonored.

<u>Eph. 6:4</u> ¶ **Fathers**, do not provoke **your children** to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

Col. 3:21 Fathers, do not exasperate your children, so that they will not lose heart.

<u>Eph. 6:1-3</u> (Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. **<u>2</u>** HONOR YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER (which is the first commandment with a promise), **<u>3</u>** SO THAT IT MAY BE WELL WITH YOU, AND THAT YOU MAY LIVE LONG ON THE EARTH.

<u>Col. 3:20</u> Children, be obedient to your parents in all things, for this is well-pleasing to the Lord.

Rom. 2:5-12 <u>5</u> But because of your stubbornness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God, <u>6</u> who WILL RENDER TO EACH PERSON ACCORDING TO HIS DEEDS: <u>7</u> to those who by perseverance in doing good seek for glory and honor and immortality, eternal life; <u>8</u> but to those who are selfishly ambitious and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, wrath and indignation. <u>9</u> *There will be* tribulation and distress for every soul of man who does evil, of the Jew first and also of the Greek,

<u>**10**</u> but glory and honor and peace to everyone who does good, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. <u>**11**</u> For there is no partiality with God.

<u>12</u> ¶ For all who have sinned without the Law will also perish without the Law, and all who have sinned under the Law will be judged by the Law;

<u>Rom. 5:1</u> ¶ Therefore, having **been justified by faith**, we have **peace with God through** our Lord Jesus Christ,

<u>1 Thess. 1:10</u> and to wait for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead, *that is* Jesus, **who rescues us from the wrath to come**.

<u>John 3:16-18</u> <u>16</u> \P "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

 $\underline{17}$ "For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him.

<u>18</u> "He who believes in Him is not judged; he who does not believe has been judged already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

Acts 4:12 "And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved."
