Philadelphia of Asia Minor. A city of the Roman province of Asia, situated on the Cogamus River, a southeastern tributary of the Hermus River. The Cogamus River valley was rich in agriculture, but subject to severe earthquakes, one of which destroyed the city in 17 AD. To encourage rebuilding of the city, the emperor Tiberius suspended the city's payment of tribute for five years, an act which was later honored by the city's adoption of the imperial name *Neocaesarea*.
