Dan. 12:1, 2 1 ¶ "Now at that time Michael, the great prince who stands *guard* over the sons of your people, will arise. And there will be a time of distress such as never occurred since there was a nation until that time; and at that time your people, everyone who is found written in the book, will be rescued. 2 "Many of those who sleep in the dust of the ground will awake, these to everlasting life, but the others to disgrace *and* everlasting contempt.

Acts 23:8 For the Sadducees say that there is no resurrection, nor an angel, nor a spirit, but the Pharisees acknowledge them all.

Acts 17:30-33 30 "Therefore having overlooked the times of ignorance, God is now declaring to men that all *people* everywhere should repent, 31 because He has fixed a day in which He will judge the world in righteousness through a Man whom He has appointed, having furnished proof to all men by raising Him from the dead." 32 Now when they heard of the resurrection of the dead, some *began* to sneer, but others said, "We shall hear you again concerning this." 33 So Paul went out of their midst.

Matt. 20:18, 19 18 "Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem; and the Son of Man will be delivered to the chief priests and scribes, and they will condemn Him to death, 19 and will hand Him over to the Gentiles to mock and scourge and crucify *Him*, and on the third day He will be raised up."

John 2:19-22 19 Jesus answered them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." 20 The Jews then said, "It took forty-six years to build this temple, and will You raise it up in three days?" 21 But He was speaking of the temple of His body.

22 So when He was raised from the dead, His disciples remembered that He said this; and they believed the Scripture and the word which Jesus had spoken.

Acts 2:23, 24 23 this *Man*, delivered over by the predetermined plan and foreknowledge of God, you nailed to a cross by the hands of godless men and put *Him* to death. 24 "But God raised Him up again, putting an end to the agony of death, since it was impossible for Him to be held in its power.

Acts 3:14, 15 14 "But you disowned the Holy and Righteous One and asked for a murderer to be granted to you, 15 but put to death the Prince of life, *the one* whom God raised from the dead, *a fact* to which we are witnesses.

Rom. 1:4 who was declared the Son of God with power by the resurrection from the dead, according to the Spirit of holiness, Jesus Christ our Lord,

<u>John 14:6</u> Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

Rom. 4:25 *He* who was delivered over because of our transgressions, and was raised because of our justification.

1 Cor. 15:20, 23 20 ¶ But now Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who are asleep. 23 But each in his own order: Christ the first fruits, after that those who are Christ's at His coming,

<u>1 Cor. 15:3-8</u> <u>3</u> ¶ For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, <u>4</u> and that He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, <u>5</u> and that He appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. <u>6</u> After that He appeared to more than five hundred brethren at one time, most of whom remain until now, but some have fallen asleep; <u>7</u> then He appeared to James, then to all the apostles; <u>8</u> and last of all, as to one untimely born, He appeared to me also.

<u>Acts 1:3</u> To these He also presented Himself alive after His suffering, by many convincing proofs, appearing to them over *a period of* forty days and speaking of the things concerning the kingdom of God.

<u>1 Cor. 15:12</u> ¶ Now if Christ is preached, that He has been raised from the dead, how do some among you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?

1 Cor. 15:13 But if there is no resurrection of the dead, not even Christ has been raised;

1 Cor. 15:14-19 14 and if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is vain, your faith also is vain. 15 Moreover we are even found *to be* false witnesses of God, because we testified against God that He raised Christ, whom He did not raise, if in fact the dead are not raised. 16 For if the dead are not raised, not even Christ has been raised; 17 and if Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins. 18 Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. 19 If we have hoped in Christ in this life only, we are of all men most to be pitied.

Rev. 20:11-15 11 ¶ Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat upon it, from whose presence earth and heaven fled away, and no place was found for them.

12 And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is *the book* of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds.

13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, every one *of them* according to their deeds.

14 Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire.

15 And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

<u>Dan. 12:2b</u> "Many of those who sleep in the dust of the ground will awake, these to everlasting life, but the others to **disgrace** and everlasting contempt.

<u>1 Cor. 15:42</u> ¶ So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown a perishable body, it is raised an imperishable body;

<u>1 Cor. 15:43a</u> it is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory; it is sown in weakness, it is raised in power;

<u>Phil. 3:20, 21</u> <u>20</u> For our citizenship is in heaven, from which also we eagerly wait for a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ;

<u>Phil. 3:21</u> who will transform the body of our humble state into conformity with the **body of His glory**, by the exertion of the power that He has even to subject all things to Himself.

<u>1 John 3:2</u> Beloved, now we are children of God, and it has not appeared as yet what we will be. We know that when He appears, we will be like Him, because we will see Him just as He is.

<u>1 Cor. 15:43b</u> it is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory; it is sown in weakness, **it is** raised in power;

<u>1 Cor. 15:44</u> it is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual *body*.

<u>1 Cor. 15:48</u> As is the earthy, so also are those who are earthy; and as is the heavenly, so also are those who are heavenly.

<u>1 Cor. 15:49</u> Just as we have borne the image of the earthy, we will also bear the image of the heavenly.

2 Cor. 5:1 \P For we know that if the earthly tent which is our house is torn down, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, **eternal in the heavens.**

<u>1 Cor. 15:54, 55, 57</u> <u>54</u> But when this perishable will have put on the imperishable, and this mortal will have put on immortality, then will come about the saying that is written, "DEATH IS SWALLOWED UP in victory. <u>55</u> "O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR VICTORY? O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR STING?" <u>57</u> but thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

<u>1 Cor. 15:58</u> ¶ Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your toil is not in vain in the Lord.

Rev. 20:4, 6 4 ¶ Then I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them. And I *saw* the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received the mark on their forehead and on their hand; and they came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. **6** Blessed and holy is the one who has a part in the first resurrection; over these the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years.
