- Revelation 3:14 - 22 (The Lord Rebukes Laodicea)

- I. THE LORD ADDRESSES LAODICEA, v-14
 - A. The Leader, v-14a
 - B. The Lord Identifies Himself As, v-14b
 - 1. The Amen, Cf. Isa. 65:16 "Truth" -Heb -affirmation, certainty, 2 Cor. 1:20; Jn. 14:6
 - 2. As The Faithful and True Witness
 - 3. The Origin of the Creation of God, Jn. 1:3; Heb. 1:2; Col. 1:15-17
 - C. He Tells Them That He Knows Their Deeds, v-15
 - --A Merely Professed Church doing deeds
 - 1. They are neither cold or hot
 - a. Not against Christ --cold
 - b. Not on fire for Christ --hot
 - 2. He wishes they were one or the other
 - a. Cold, so He could send some one like Paul, Acts 26:18
 - b. Hot, so He could fan their zeal for Him to greater commitment
 - D. He Told Them They Are Lukewarm, v-16
 - 1. Their Real Spiritual condition!
 - 2. Lukewarm like the piped water from their underground aqueduct --dirty, lukewarm
