Rev. 3:14 ¶ "To the angel of **the church in Laodicea** write: ¶ The **Amen**, the **faithful and true Witness**, the **Beginning** of the creation of God, says this:

<u>Isa. 65:16</u> "Because he who is blessed in the earth Will be blessed by **the God of truth**; And he who swears in the earth Will swear by **the God of truth**; Because the former troubles are forgotten, And because they are hidden from My sight!

<u>2 Cor. 1:20</u> For as many as are the **promises of God, in Him they are yes**; therefore also through Him is **our Amen** to the glory of God through us.

<u>John 14:6</u> Jesus said to him, "I am the way, **and the truth**, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

<u>John 1:3</u> All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being.

<u>Heb. 1:2</u> in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, **through whom also He made the world**.

<u>Col. 1:15-17</u> ¶ He is **the image of the invisible God**, the **firstborn** of all creation. <u>16</u> For **by Him all things were created**, *both* in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities — all things have been created through Him and for Him. <u>17</u> He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together.

Rev. 3:15 ¶ 'I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot; I wish that you were cold or hot.

<u>Acts 26:18</u> to **open their eyes** so that they **may turn from** darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.'

Rev. 3:16 'So because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of My mouth.

Rev. 3:17 'Because you say, "I am rich, and have become wealthy, and have need of nothing," and you do not know that you are wretched and miserable and poor and blind and naked,

<u>Rev. 3:18</u> I advise you to **buy from Me gold refined** by fire so that you may become rich, and **white garments** so that you may clothe yourself, and *that* **the shame of your nakedness will not** be revealed; and **eye salve to anoint your eyes** so that **you may see**.

<u>Rev. 3:5</u> 'He who overcomes will thus be clothed in white garments; and I will not erase his name from the book of life, and I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels.

Rev. 4:4 Around the throne *were* twenty-four thrones; and upon the thrones *I saw* twenty-four elders sitting, **clothed in white garments**, and golden crowns on their heads.

Rev. 7:9 ¶ After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could count, from **every nation and** *all* **tribes and peoples and tongues**, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, **clothed in white robes**, and palm branches *were* in their hands;

Rev. 7:13 ¶ Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, "These who are clothed in the white robes, who are they, and where have they come from?"

<u>Rev. 7:14</u> I said to him, "My lord, you know." And he said to me, "These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

<u>Acts 26:18</u> to **open their eyes** so that they may **turn from darkness to light** and from the dominion of Satan to God, that they **may receive forgiveness of sins** and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.'

Rev. 3:19 'Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline; therefore be zealous and repent.

Rom. 5:8 But God demonstrates **His own love toward us**, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Eph. 2:4 But God, being rich in mercy, **because of His great love with which He loved us,**

Rom. 3:23 for **all have sinned** and fall short of the glory of God,

Rev. 3:20 'Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and will dine with him, and he with Me.

<u>John 6:37</u> "All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will certainly not cast out.

<u>Rev. 3:21</u> 'He who overcomes, I will grant to him to sit down with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.

<u>Rev. 20:6</u> Blessed and holy is the one who has a part in the first resurrection; over these the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of **Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years.**

Rev. 3:22 'He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches."
