<u>1 Tim. 3:16</u> By common confession, great is the mystery of godliness: He who was revealed in the flesh, Was vindicated in the Spirit, Seen by angels, Proclaimed among the nations, Believed on in the world, Taken up in glory.

<u>Isa. 9:6</u> For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called **Wonderful Counselor**, **Mighty God**, **Eternal Father**, Prince of Peace.

<u>John 3:34</u> "For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God; for He gives the Spirit without measure.

Acts 10:38 "You know of Jesus of Nazareth, how God anointed Him with the Holy Spirit and with power, and how He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

<u>Heb. 1:6</u> And when He again brings the firstborn into the world, He says, "AND LET ALL **THE ANGELS OF GOD** WORSHIP HIM."

Acts 10:42-47 42 "And He ordered us to preach to the people, and solemnly to testify that this is the One who has been appointed by God as Judge of the living and the dead. 43 "Of Him all the prophets bear witness that through His name everyone who believes in Him receives forgiveness of sins." 44 ¶ While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who were listening to the message. 45 All the circumcised believers who came with Peter were amazed, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also. 46 For they were hearing them speaking with tongues and exalting God. Then Peter answered, 47 "Surely no one can refuse the water for these to be baptized who have received the Holy Spirit just as we did, can he?"

Acts 26:17 rescuing you from the Jewish people and from the Gentiles, to whom I am sending you,

Acts 26:18 to open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.'

Matt. 28:18-20 18 And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Acts 13:46-48 46 Paul and Barnabas spoke out boldly and said, "It was necessary that the word of God be spoken to you first; since you repudiate it and judge yourselves unworthy of eternal life, behold, we are turning to the Gentiles. 47 "For so the Lord has commanded us, 'I HAVE PLACED YOU AS A LIGHT FOR THE GENTILES, THAT YOU MAY BRING SALVATION TO THE END OF THE EARTH." 48 ¶ When the Gentiles heard this, they began rejoicing and glorifying the word of the Lord; and as many as had been appointed to eternal life believed.

Acts 1:9-11 9 And after He had said these things, He was lifted up while they were looking on, and a cloud received Him out of their sight. 10 And as they were gazing intently into the sky while He was going, behold, two men in white clothing stood beside them. 11 They also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into the sky? This Jesus, who has been taken up from you into heaven, will come in just the same way as you have watched Him go into heaven."

- Acts 5:31 "He is the one whom God exalted to His right hand as a Prince and a Savior, to grant repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins.
- 1 Pet. 3:22 who is at the right hand of God, having gone into heaven, after angels and authorities and powers had been subjected to Him.

- **Eph. 5:1** ¶ Therefore **be imitators of God**, as beloved children;
- <u>1 Pet. 1:15, 16</u> but like the Holy One who called you, **be holy yourselves also in all** *your* **behavior**;

<u>1 Pet. 1:16</u> because it is written, "YOU SHALL BE HOLY, FOR I AM HOLY."

<u>1 Tim. 4:7, 8</u> <u>7b</u> But have nothing to do with worldly fables fit only for old women. On the other hand, **discipline yourself for the purpose of godliness**; <u>8</u> for **bodily discipline is only of little profit**, but **godliness is** profitable for all things, since it **holds promise for the present life** and *also* for **the** *life* **to come**.

- <u>1 Tim. 6:5</u> and constant friction between men of depraved mind and deprived of the truth, who suppose that godliness is a means of gain.
- <u>1 Cor. 9:14</u> So also the Lord directed those who proclaim the gospel to get their living from the gospel.

<u>1 Tim. 6:6</u> But godliness *actually* is a means of great gain when accompanied by contentment.

- <u>Titus 1:1</u> ¶ Paul, a bond-servant of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ, for the faith of those chosen of God and the knowledge of the truth which is according to godliness,
- <u>2 Tim. 4:2-4</u> <u>2</u> preach the word; be ready in season *and* out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction. <u>3</u> For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but wanting to have their ears tickled, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance to their own desires, <u>4</u> and will turn away their ears from the truth and will turn aside to myths.

<u>2 Pet. 1:3</u> seeing that His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence.

<u>2 Pet. 1:5, 6</u> <u>5</u> Now for this very reason also, applying all diligence, in your faith supply moral excellence, and in *your* moral excellence, knowledge, <u>6</u> and in *your* knowledge, self-control, and in *your* self-control, perseverance, and **in** *your* **perseverance**, **godliness**,

- <u>2 Pet. 1:7</u> and in *your* godliness, brotherly kindness, and in *your* brotherly kindness, love.
- <u>2 Pet. 3:9-11</u> The Lord is **not slow about His promise**, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, **not wishing for any to perish** but for all to come to repentance.
- 10 But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, in which the heavens will pass away with a roar and the elements will be destroyed with intense heat, and the earth and its works will be burned up.
