<u>**2** Sam. 7:1-3, 11b-13, 16</u> <u>1</u> Now it came about when the king lived in his house, and the LORD had given him rest on every side from all his enemies, <u>2</u> that the king said to Nathan the prophet, "See now, I dwell in a house of cedar, but the ark of God dwells within tent curtains."

<u>3</u> Nathan said to the king, "Go, do all that is in your mind, for the LORD is with you."

<u>2 Sam. 7:16</u> "Your house and your kingdom shall endure before Me forever; your throne shall be established forever.""

Isa. 7:14 "Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, a virgin will be with child and bear a son, and she will call His name Immanuel.

Matt. 1:21-2321"She will bear a Son; and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will
save His people from their sins."22Now all this took place to fulfill what was spoken
by the Lord through the prophet:23"BEHOLD, THE VIRGIN SHALL BEWITH CHILD AND SHALL BEAR A SON, AND THEY SHALL CALL HIS NAME
IMMANUEL," which translated means, "GOD WITH US."

<u>Isa. 9:6</u> For a child will be born to us, **a son will be given to us**; And **the government** will rest on His shoulders; And **His name** will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.

John 1:45-51 45 Philip found Nathanael and said to him, "We have found Him of whom Moses in the Law and *also* the Prophets wrote — Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph." **46** Nathanael said to him, "Can any good thing come out of Nazareth?" Philip said to him, "Come and see." **47** Jesus saw Nathanael coming to Him, and said of him, "Behold, an Israelite indeed, in whom there is no deceit!" **48** Nathanael said to Him, "How do You know me?" Jesus answered and said to him, "Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree, I saw you." **49** Nathanael answered Him, "Rabbi, **You are the Son of God; You are the King of Israel**." **50** Jesus answered and said to him, "Because I said to you that I saw you under the fig tree, do you believe? You will see greater things than these."

John 1:51 And He said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, you will see the heavens opened and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man."_

Matt. 4:17 ¶ From that time Jesus began to preach and say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

Matt. 3:2 "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

<u>Matt. 11:20</u> ¶ Then He began to denounce the cities in which most of His miracles were done, because they did not repent.

John 3:1-7 <u>1</u> Now there was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews; <u>2</u> this man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know that You have come from God *as* a teacher; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him." <u>3</u> Jesus answered and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is **born again he cannot see the kingdom of God**." <u>4</u> Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? He cannot enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born, can he?" <u>5</u> Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit he **cannot enter into the kingdom of God**. <u>6</u> "That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. **7** "Do not be amazed that I said to you, 'You must be born again.'

John 6:38 "For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

Luke 19:10 "For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."

Matt. 20:28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

Isa. 53:6 All of us like sheep have gone astray, Each of us has turned to his own way; But the LORD has caused the iniquity of us all To fall on Him.

Isa. 53:11 As a result of the anguish of His soul, He will see *it and* be satisfied; By His knowledge the Righteous One, My Servant, will justify the many, As He will bear their iniquities.

<u>Matt. 8:24-27</u> 24 And behold, there arose a great storm on the sea, so that the boat was being covered with the waves; but Jesus Himself was asleep. 25 And they came to *Him* and woke Him, saying, "Save *us*, Lord; we are perishing!" 26 He said to them, "Why are you afraid, you men of little faith?" Then He got up and rebuked the winds and the sea, and it became perfectly calm.

Matt. 8:27 The men were amazed, and said, "What kind of a man is this, that even the winds and the sea obey Him?"

<u>Matt. 23:27</u> ¶ "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you are like whitewashed tombs which on the outside appear beautiful, but inside they are full of dead men's bones and all uncleanness.

<u>John 5:18</u> For this reason therefore **the Jews were seeking all the more to kill Him,** because He not only was breaking the Sabbath, but also was calling God His own Father, making Himself **equal with God**.

Matt. 12:22-28, 31, 3222 \P Then a demon-possessed man who was blind and mute
was brought to Jesus, and He healed him, so that the mute man spoke and saw.23All the crowds were amazed, and were saying, "This man cannot be the Son of David,
can he?2424But when the Pharisees heard this, they said, "This man casts out demons
only by Beelzebul the ruler of the demons."259And knowing their thoughts Jesus
said to them, "Any kingdom divided against itself is laid waste; and any city or house
divided against itself will not stand.2626"If Satan casts out Satan, he is divided against
himself; how then will his kingdom stand?2727"If I by Beelzebul cast out demons, by
whom do your sons cast them out? For this reason they will be your judges.2828"But if
I cast out demons by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God has come upon you.

 $\underline{31}$ ¶ "Therefore I say to you, any sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven people, but blasphemy against the Spirit shall not be forgiven. $\underline{32}$ "Whoever speaks a word against the Son of Man, it shall be forgiven him; but whoever **speaks against the Holy Spirit, it shall not be forgiven him, either in this age or in the** *age* **to come**.

<u>Matt. 21:1-5</u> 1 ¶ When they had approached Jerusalem and had come to Bethphage, at the Mount of Olives, then Jesus sent two disciples, 2 saying to them, "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied *there* and a colt with her; untie them and bring them to Me. 3 "If anyone says anything to you, you shall say, 'The Lord has need of them,' and immediately he will send them." 4 This took place to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet: 5 "SAY TO THE DAUGHTER OF ZION, 'BEHOLD YOUR KING IS COMING TO YOU, GENTLE, AND MOUNTED ON A DONKEY, EVEN ON A COLT, THE FOAL OF A BEAST OF BURDEN."

<u>Mark 11:4-7</u> <u>4</u> They went away and found a colt tied at the door, outside in the street; and they untied it. <u>5</u> Some of the bystanders were saying to them, "What are you doing, untying the colt?" <u>6</u> They spoke to them just as Jesus had told *them*, and they gave them permission. <u>7</u> They brought the colt to Jesus and put their coats on it; and He sat on it.

<u>Matt. 21:8</u> Most of the crowd spread their coats in the road, and others were cutting branches from the trees and spreading them in the road.

<u>Matt. 21:9</u> The crowds going ahead of Him, and those who followed, were shouting, "Hosanna to the Son of David; BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD; Hosanna in the highest!"

<u>Mark 11:10</u> Blessed *is* the coming kingdom of our father David; Hosanna in the highest!"

Luke 19:37, 38 37 As soon as He was approaching, near the descent of the Mount of Olives, the whole crowd of the disciples began to praise God joyfully with a loud voice for all the miracles which they had seen, <u>38</u> shouting: "BLESSED IS THE KING WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD; Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"

John 12:12, 13, 16-18 12 ¶ On the next day the large crowd who had come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, 13 took the branches of the palm trees and went out to meet Him, and *began* to shout, "Hosanna! BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD, even the King of Israel."

John 12:16-18 16 These things His disciples did not understand at the first; but when Jesus was glorified, then they remembered that these things were written of Him, and that they had done these things to Him. 17 So the people, who were with Him when He called Lazarus out of the tomb and raised him from the dead, continued to testify *about Him*. 18 For this reason also the people went and met Him, because they heard that He had performed this sign

Luke 19:39 Some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to Him, "Teacher, rebuke Your disciples."

Luke 19:40 But Jesus answered, "I tell you, if these become silent, the stones will cry out!"

Luke 19:41-44 41 ¶ When He approached *Jerusalem*, He saw the city and wept over it, <u>42</u> saying, "If you had known in this day, even you, the things which make for peace! But now they have been hidden from your eyes. <u>43</u> "For the days will come upon you when your enemies will throw up a barricade against you, and surround you and hem you in on every side, <u>44</u> and they will level you to the ground and your children within you, and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not recognize the time of your visitation."

Acts 26:17 rescuing you from the *Jewish* people and from the Gentiles, to whom I am sending you,

<u>Acts 26:18</u> to open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.'

Matt. 23:39 "For I say to you, from now on you will not see Me until you say, 'BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD!""

<u>Zech. 12:10</u> ¶ "I will pour out on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the Spirit of grace and of supplication, so that they will look on Me whom they have pierced; and they will mourn for Him, as one mourns for an only son, and they will weep bitterly over Him like the bitter weeping over a firstborn.

<u>Zech. 13:1</u> ¶ "In that day a fountain will be opened for the house of David and for the inhabitants of Jerusalem, for sin and for impurity.

<u>Rom. 11:25-27</u> 25 ¶ For I do not want you, brethren, to be uninformed of this mystery — so that you will not be wise in your own estimation — that a partial hardening has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in;

<u>Rom. 11:26</u> and **so all Israel will be saved;** just as it is written, "THE DELIVERER WILL COME FROM ZION, HE WILL REMOVE UNGODLINESS FROM JACOB."

<u>Rom. 11:27</u> "THIS IS MY COVENANT WITH THEM, **WHEN I TAKE AWAY** THEIR SINS."
