

Decapolis A confederation of ten Hellenistic cities (*decapolis* is Greek for “ten cities”) located primarily on the eastern side of the Jordan River to the southeast of the Sea of Galilee. Since ancient times, there has been some uncertainty as to precisely which cities made up the ten cities of the Decapolis, . . .
