<u>**1** Pet. 2:1, 2</u> <u>1</u> Therefore, putting aside all malice and all deceit and hypocrisy and envy and all slander, <u>2</u> like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may grow in respect to salvation,

<u>2 Pet. 3:18</u> but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him *be* the glory, both now and to the day of eternity. Amen.

<u>**2** Cor. 6:14-18</u> <u>14</u> ¶ Do not be bound together with unbelievers; for what partnership have righteousness and lawlessness, or what fellowship has light with darkness?

<u>15</u> Or what harmony has Christ with Belial, or what has a believer in common with an unbeliever?

<u>16</u> Or what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; just as God said, "I WILL DWELL IN THEM AND WALK AMONG THEM; AND I WILL BE THEIR GOD, AND THEY SHALL BE MY PEOPLE.

<u>17</u> "Therefore, **COME OUT FROM THEIR MIDST AND BE SEPARATE**," says the Lord. "AND **DO NOT TOUCH** WHAT IS UNCLEAN; **And I will welcome you**.

<u>18</u> "And I will be a father to you, And you shall be sons and daughters to Me," Says the Lord Almighty.

Ex. 21:15 ¶ "He who strikes his father or his mother shall surely be put to death.

Ex. 21:17 ¶ "He who **curses** his father or his mother shall surely be put to death.

<u>Deut. 27:16</u> ¶ 'Cursed is he who dishonors his father or mother.' And all the people shall say, 'Amen.'

<u>Prov. 23:22</u> ¶ Listen to your father who begot you, And **do not despise** your mother when she is old.

Ex. 20:12 ¶ "Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be prolonged in the land which the LORD your God gives you.

<u>Eph. 6:2</u> HONOR YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER (which is the first commandment with a promise),

<u>1 Pet. 3:7</u> ¶ You husbands in the same way, live with *your wives* in an **understanding way**, as with someone weaker, since she is a woman; and **show her honor as a fellow heir of the grace of life**, so that your prayers will not be hindered.
