Eph. 4:1-3 1 ¶ Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called, $\underline{2}$ with all humility and gentleness, with patience, showing tolerance for one another in love, $\underline{3}$ being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Phil. 1:2 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Col. 1:2 ¶ To the saints and faithful brethren in Christ *who are* at Colossae: Grace to you **and peace** from God our Father.

Phil. 4:9 The things you have learned and received and heard and seen in me, practice these things, and **the God of peace** will be with you.

<u>Matt. 5:9</u> ¶ "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God.

2 Tim. 2:3 Suffer hardship with me, as a good soldier of Christ Jesus.

<u>2 Tim. 4:5</u> But you, be sober in all things, **endure hardship**, do the **work of an evangelist**, fulfill your ministry.

Eph. 6:11-13 11 Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil. 12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual *forces* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*. 13 Therefore, take up the full armor of God, so that you will be able to resist in the evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm.

<u>Heb. 13:17</u> ¶ Obey your leaders and submit *to them*, for they keep watch over your souls as those who will give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with grief, for this would be unprofitable for you.

<u>1 Thess. 5:13</u> and that you esteem them very highly in love because of their work. Live in peace with one another.

<u>1 Tim. 5:17</u> ¶ The elders who rule well are to be considered worthy of double honor, especially those who work hard at preaching and teaching.

Acts 20:17-32 17 ¶ From Miletus he sent to Ephesus and called to him the elders of 18 And when they had come to him, he said to them, ¶ "You yourselves the church. know, from the first day that I set foot in Asia, how I was with you the whole time, 19 serving the Lord with all humility and with tears and with trials which came upon me through the plots of the Jews; 20 how I did not shrink from declaring to you anything that was profitable, and teaching you publicly and from house to house, 21 solemnly testifying to both Jews and Greeks of repentance toward God and faith in 22 "And now, behold, bound by the Spirit, I am on my way to our Lord Jesus Christ. Jerusalem, not knowing what will happen to me there, 23 except that the Holy Spirit solemnly testifies to me in every city, saying that bonds and afflictions await me. 24 "But I do not consider my life of any account as dear to myself, so that I may finish my course and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify solemnly of the gospel of the grace of God. 25 ¶ "And now, behold, I know that all of you, among whom I went about preaching the kingdom, will no longer see my face. 26 "Therefore, I testify to you this day that I am innocent of the blood of all men. 27 "For I did not shrink from declaring to you the whole purpose of God. 28 "Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to **shepherd the church of God** which He purchased with His own blood. 29 "I know that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; 30 and from among your own selves men will arise, speaking 31 "Therefore be on the perverse things, to draw away the disciples after them. alert, remembering that night and day for a period of three years I did not cease to 32 "And now I commend you to God and to the admonish each one with tears. word of His grace, which is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified.

<u>2 Cor. 11:13-15</u> <u>13</u> For such men are false apostles, deceitful workers, disguising themselves as apostles of Christ. <u>14</u> No wonder, for even **Satan disguises himself** as an angel of light. <u>15</u> Therefore it is not surprising if **his servants also disguise** themselves as servants of righteousness, whose end will be according to their deeds.

John 4:22 "You worship what you do not know; we worship what we know, for salvation is from the Jews. 23 "But an hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for such people the Father seeks to be His worshipers. 24 "God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

<u>James 1:22</u> But prove yourselves doers of the word, and not merely hearers who delude themselves.

<u>1Tim. 4:1</u> ¶ But the Spirit explicitly says that in later times some will fall away from the faith, paying attention to deceitful spirits and doctrines of demons,

1 Cor. 15:17-20 17 and if Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins. 18 Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished.
19 If we have hoped in Christ in this life only, we are of all men most to be pitied.
20 ¶ But now Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who are asleep.

<u>1 Pet. 2:2</u> like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may grow in respect to salvation,

Eph. 2:8-10 8 For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; **9 not as a result of works**, so that no one may boast. **10** For we are **His workmanship**, created in Christ Jesus **for good works**, which God **prepared beforehand** so that **we would walk in them**.

<u>1 Tim. 2:9, 10 9</u> Likewise, *I want* women to adorn themselves with proper clothing, modestly and discreetly, not with braided hair and gold or pearls or costly garments, <u>10</u> but rather **by means of good works**, as is proper for women making a claim to godliness.

<u>1 Tim. 6:17-19</u> ¶ Instruct those who are rich in this present world not to be conceited or to fix their hope on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, who richly supplies us with all things to enjoy. <u>18</u> Instruct them to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share, <u>19</u> storing up for themselves the treasure of a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of that which is life indeed.

<u>Col. 3:23, 24</u> <u>23</u> Whatever you do, **do your work heartily, as for the Lord** rather than for men, <u>24</u> knowing that **from the Lord you will receive the reward** of the inheritance. It is the **Lord Christ whom you serve**.

<u>Phil. 4:2, 3</u> ¶ I urge Euodia and I urge Syntyche to live in harmony in the Lord. <u>3</u> Indeed, true companion, I ask you also to help these women who have shared my struggle in the cause of the gospel, together with Clement also and the rest of my fellow workers, whose names are in the book of life.
