Sermon Scriptures

<u>John 3:16</u> For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

========

Eph. 2:4 ¶ But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us,

Rom. 5:8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

========

Eph. 5:2 And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet smelling savour.

Luke 19:10 For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.

<u>John 6:38-40</u> 38 For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.

John 6:39 And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.

<u>John 6:40</u> And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.

<u>John 14:6</u> Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

<u>John 1:29</u> ¶ The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

Acts 4:10 Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, *even* by him doth this man stand here before you whole.

Acts 4:12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

<u>1 Tim. 1:15</u> This *is* a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.

- <u>1 John 5:20</u> And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, *even* in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.
- **John 4:39-42** 39 And many of the Samaritans of that city believed on him for the saying of the woman, which testified, He told me all that ever I did.
- <u>John 4:40</u> So when the Samaritans were come unto him, they besought him that he would tarry with them: and he abode there two days.
- **John 4:41** And many more believed because of his own word;
- <u>John 4:42</u> And said unto the woman, Now we believe, not because of thy saying: for we have heard *him* ourselves, and know that this is indeed the Christ, the Saviour of the world.
- **2** Cor. 5:10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things *done* in *his* body, according to that he hath done, whether *it be* good or bad.
- Matt. 7:21 ¶ Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.
- Mark 8:37 Or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?
- <u>1 Cor. 15:4-6</u> <u>4</u> And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:
- <u>**1 Cor. 15:5</u>** And that he was seen of Cephas, then of the twelve:</u>
- <u>1 Cor. 15:6</u> After that, he was seen of above five hundred brethren at once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present, but some are fallen asleep.
- <u>John 5:18</u> Therefore the Jews sought the more to kill him, because he not only had broken the sabbath, but said also that God was his Father, making himself equal with God.
- **John 8:56-59** Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw *it*, and was glad.
- <u>John 8:57</u> Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham?
- <u>John 8:58</u> Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.

<u>John 8:59</u> Then took they up stones to cast at him: but Jesus hid himself, and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by.

2 Tim. 3:16 All scripture *is* given by inspiration of God, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

John 17:17 ¶ Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.

Matt. 24:35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.
