Mic. 6:8 He has told you, O man, what is good; And what does the LORD require of you But to do justice, to love kindness, And to **walk humbly** with your God?

Luke 14:11 "For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted."

James 4:10 Humble yourselves in the presence of the Lord, and He will exalt you.

<u>**1** Pet. 5:5</u> You younger men, likewise, be subject to *your* elders; and all of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, for GOD IS OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE HUMBLE.

<u>Eph. 4:1, 2</u> Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called, <u>2</u> with all humility and gentleness, with patience, showing tolerance for one another in love,

<u>Col. 3:12</u> ¶ So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience;

<u>Phil. 2:3, 4</u> <u>3</u> Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves; <u>4</u> do not *merely* look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others.

Phil. 2:5 Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus,

Phil. 2:6 who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped,

Phil. 2:7 but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, *and* being made in the likeness of men.

John 17:5 "Now, Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was.

John 4:34 Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me and to accomplish His work.

<u>John 5:30</u> ¶ "I can do nothing on My own initiative. As I hear, I judge; and My judgment is just, because I do not seek My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

<u>John 6:38, 39</u> <u>38</u> "For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me. <u>39</u> "This is the will of Him who sent Me, that of all that He has given Me I lose nothing, but raise it up on the last day.

Matt. 12:24 But when the Pharisees heard *this,* they said, "This man casts out demons only by Beelzebul the ruler of the demons."

<u>Matt. 12:31, 32</u> <u>31</u> ¶ "Therefore I say to you, any sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven people, but blasphemy against the Spirit shall not be forgiven. <u>32</u> "Whoever speaks a word against the Son of Man, it shall be forgiven him; but whoever speaks against the Holy Spirit, it shall not be forgiven him, either in this age or in the *age* to come.

Phil. 2:7 but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, *and* being made in the likeness of men.

Phil. 2:8 Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

<u>**1 Pet. 2:22</u>** WHO COMMITTED NO SIN, NOR WAS ANY DECEIT FOUND IN HIS MOUTH;</u>

Phil. 2:9 For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name,

Acts 2:33 "Therefore having been exalted to the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He has poured forth this which you both see and hear.

Acts 5:31 "He is the one whom God exalted to His right hand as a Prince and a Savior, to grant repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins.

<u>**1** Pet. 3:22</u> who is at the right hand of God, having gone into heaven, after angels and authorities and powers had been subjected to Him.

Phil. 2:9 For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name,

Phil. 2:10 so that at the name of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth,

Phil. 2:11 and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

<u>**1** Tim. 6:15</u> which He will bring about at the proper time — He who is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings and Lord of lords,

<u>Rev. 17:14</u> "These will wage war against the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, because He is Lord of lords and King of kings, and those who are with Him *are the* called and chosen and faithful."

<u>Rev. 19:14-16</u> 14 And the armies which are in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white *and* clean, were following Him on white horses.

15 From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty.

<u>16</u> And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written, "KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS."
