

Galilee . . . The northernmost district of Israel, encompassing primarily the regions of Zebulun and Naphtali (Isaiah 9:1; Joshua 20:7; 21:32; 2 Kings 15:29; 1 Chronicles 6:26). Bordered by Phoenicia to the west and Aram to the north and east, the region is sometimes referred to as “**Galilee of the Gentiles**” (Isaiah 9:1; . . .



Jesus grew up in Galilee (Matthew 2:22-23; Luke 2:39-40), and it was the primary focus of his **ministry** (Matthew 4:23; Mark 1:29; Luke 4:14; 23:5; John 7:1). Most of his disciples were from Galilee, and it was there that he appeared to them after his resurrection (Matthew 26:32; 28:7, 10, 16-20; John 21:1).
