F. Salvation Is Through Jesus Christ, God's Son

Alone! Rom. 1:16; Rom. 5:21; 1 Thess. 5:9;

Cf. Acts 4:12; Jn. 14:6

1. Salvation comes through faith in Christ,  
Eph. 2:8a; Rom. 10:17
2. Salvation is a free gift from God, Eph. 2:8b;  
Rom. 6:23  
--It can't be purchased by doing good  
deeds  
--No other Religion can provide it.

G. God Invites Us To Come To Him For Salvation,  
--Young People, Adults, Old People, Children

1. The Lord called the lost to Himself,  
Mt. 11:28, 29; Mk. 10:13, 14; Jn. 6:37
2. God Wants Us To Receive His Free Gift Of  
Salvation, 1 Tim. 2:3, 4
3. God called Israel to Himself in the O. T.,  
Isa. 45:21, 22
4. Christ Invites Us the Gentile Peoples of  
the world to Himself, Acts 26:16-18
5. Christ declared His Mission to Israel,  
Lk. 19:10
6. Paul stated clearly Christ's Mission and  
sought to follow it, 1 Tim. 1:15; 1 Cor. 9:22
7. We must not ignore or reject God's Call to  
salvation. It is our Only Hope! 1 Cor. 1:18

H. Faith In Christ Comes Through Hearing God's  
Word, Rom. 10:17 --Don't run from God's Word.

I. Genuine Salvation Makes Us God's Children,  
1 Jn. 3:1-3; Rom. 8:16; Phil. 2:15

J. God Wants To Save Us From The Agony Of  
Eternal Punishment

--Many reject the idea. Darken human  
reason vs God's Revelation.

1. The Lord described Hell as a place of  
Torment, Lk. 16:23
2. The Lord described Hell as everlasting  
fire and punishment, Mt. 25:41, 46
3. The Lord described Hell as a place of  
weeping and gnashing of teeth, Mt. 13:42;  
Mt. 8:12
4. Paul affirmed the eternal punishment of  
the Lost, 2 Thess. 1:9
5. The Lord described the final place for the  
Lost of Mankind after the Judgment to be  
the Lake of Fire, Rev. 20:15

K. God Has Secured The Salvation Of Genuine  
Believers In Christ!

1. Mere professors in Christ will not be saved,  
Mt. 7:21-23
2. The Lord spoke of the Security of Salvation,  
Jn. 10:27-30; Jn. 6:37-40
3. Paul spoke of the Security of Genuine  
Believers in Christ, Rom. 8:1, 35-39
