Matt. 11:28, 29 28 ¶ "Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. 29 "Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and YOU WILL FIND REST FOR YOUR SOULS.

Mark 10:13, 14 13 ¶ And they were bringing children to Him so that He might touch them; but the disciples rebuked them. 14 But when Jesus saw this, He was indignant and said to them, "Permit the children to come to Me; do not hinder them; for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these.

<u>John 6:37</u> "All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will certainly not cast out.

<u>1 Tim. 2:3, 4</u> This is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, <u>4</u> who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

<u>Isa. 45:21, 22 21</u> "Declare and set forth *your case;* Indeed, let them consult together. Who has announced this from of old? Who has long since declared it? Is it not I, the LORD? And there is no other God besides Me, A righteous God and a Savior; There is none except Me. <u>22</u> "Turn to Me and be saved, all the ends of the earth; For I am God, and there is no other.

Acts 26:16-18 16 'But get up and stand on your feet; for this purpose I have appeared to you, to appoint you a minister and a witness not only to the things which you have seen, but also to the things in which I will appear to you; 17 rescuing you from the Jewish people and from the Gentiles, to whom I am sending you, 18 to open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.'

Luke 19:10 "For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."

<u>1 Tim. 1:15</u> It is a trustworthy statement, deserving full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, among whom I am foremost *of all*.

<u>1 Cor. 9:22</u> To the weak I became weak, that I might win the weak; I have become all things to all men, so **that I may by all means save some.** 

<u>1 Cor. 1:18</u> ¶ For the word of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

Rom. 10:17 So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.

<u>1 John 3:1-3</u> ¶ See how great a love the Father has bestowed on us, **that we would** be called children of God; and *such* we are. For this reason the world does not know us, because it did not know Him. <u>2</u> Beloved, **now we are children of God**, and it has not appeared as yet what we will be. We know that when He appears, we will be like Him, because we will see Him just as He is. <u>3</u> And everyone who has this hope *fixed* on Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.

Rom. 8:16 The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God,

<u>Phil. 2:15</u> so that you will prove yourselves to be blameless and innocent, **children of God** above reproach in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you appear as lights in the world,

<u>Luke 16:23</u> "In Hades he lifted up his eyes, **being in torment**, and saw Abraham far away and Lazarus in his bosom.

Matt. 25:41, 46 41 ¶ "Then He will also say to those on His left, 'Depart from Me, accursed ones, into the eternal fire which has been prepared for the devil and his angels; 46 "These will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."

<u>Matt. 13:42</u> and will throw them into the furnace of fire; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Matt. 8:12 but the sons of the kingdom will be cast out into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."

<u>2 Thess. 1:9</u> These will pay the penalty of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power,

**Rev. 20:15** And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, **he was** thrown into the lake of fire.

Matt. 7:21-23 21 ¶ "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven will enter. 22 "Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?' 23 "And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; DEPART FROM ME, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS.'

<u>John 10:27-30</u> 27 "My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me; 28 and I give eternal life to them, and they will never perish; and no one will snatch them out of My hand. 29 "My Father, who has given *them* to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch *them* out of the Father's hand. 30 "I and the Father are one."

John 6:37-40 37 "All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will certainly not cast out. 38 "For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me. 39 "This is the will of Him who sent Me, that of all that He has given Me I lose nothing, but raise it up on the last day. 40 "For this is the will of My Father, that everyone who beholds the Son and believes in Him will have eternal life, and I Myself will raise him up on the last day."

Rom. 8:1, 35-39 1 ¶ Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

Rom. 8:35-39 35 Who will separate us from the love of Christ? Will tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? 36 Just as it is written, "FOR YOUR SAKE WE ARE BEING PUT TO DEATH ALL DAY LONG; WE WERE CONSIDERED AS SHEEP TO BE SLAUGHTERED." 37 But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us. 38 For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, 39 nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
