Sunday, November 19, 2023 Sermon Scriptures

<u>1 John 3:1</u> ¶ See how great a love the Father has bestowed on us, that we would be called **children of God; and** *such* we are. For this reason the world does not know us, because it did not know Him.

<u>1 John 3:2</u> Beloved, now we are children of God, and it has not appeared as yet what we will be. We know that when He appears, we will be like Him, because we will see Him just as He is.

<u>1 John 3:3</u> And everyone who has **this hope** *fixed* **on Him purifies himself**, just as He is pure.

Acts 26:18 to open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.'

<u>John 15:19</u> "If you were of the world, the world would love its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, because of this the world hates you.

<u>Rom. 12:2</u> And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

<u>1 Pet. 1:15, 16</u> but like the Holy One who called you, **be holy yourselves** also in **all your behavior**; <u>16</u> because it is written, "YOU SHALL BE HOLY, FOR I AM HOLY."

John 17:17 "Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth.

<u>Eph. 5:8</u> for you were **formerly darkness**, but now **you are Light in the Lord**; walk as children of Light

Gal. 5:19-21 19 Now the deeds of the flesh are evident, which are: immorality, impurity, sensuality, 20 idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, disputes, dissensions, factions, 21 envying, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these, of which I forewarn you, just as I have forewarned you, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

Gal. 5:22-24 22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

<u>Gal. 5:24</u> Now those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

Rev. 19:7-9 7 "Let us rejoice and be glad and give the glory to Him, for the marriage of the Lamb has come and His bride has made herself ready." 8 It was given to her to clothe herself in fine linen, bright and clean; for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints. $9 \text{ Then he said to me, "Write, 'Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb." And he said to me, "These are true words of God."$

Eph. 5:22-24 ¶ Wives, be subject to your own husbands, as to the Lord. 23 For the husband is the head of the wife, as Christ also is the head of the church, He Himself being the Savior of the body. 24 But as the church is subject to Christ, so also the wives ought to be to their husbands in everything.

Eph. 5:25-30 ¶ Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her, 26 so that He might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, 27 that He might present to Himself the church in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she would be holy and blameless. 28 So husbands ought also to love their own wives as their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself; 29 for no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ also does the church, 30 because we are members of His body.

Eph. 6:1-3 1 ¶ Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. 2 HONOR YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER (which is the first commandment with a promise), 3 SO THAT IT MAY BE WELL WITH YOU, AND THAT YOU MAY LIVE LONG ON THE EARTH.

Matt. 19:3-9 3 ¶ Some Pharisees came to Jesus, testing Him and asking, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for any reason at all?" 4 And He answered and said, "Have you not read that He who created them from the beginning MADE THEM MALE AND FEMALE, 5 and said, 'FOR THIS REASON A MAN SHALL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND MOTHER AND BE JOINED TO HIS WIFE, AND THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH'? 6 "So they are no longer two, but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let no man separate." 7 They said to Him, "Why then did Moses command to GIVE HER A CERTIFICATE OF DIVORCE AND SEND her AWAY?" 8 He said to them, "Because of your hardness of heart Moses permitted you to divorce your wives; but from the beginning it has not been this way. 9 "And I say to you, whoever divorces his wife, except for immorality, and marries another woman commits adultery."

2 Cor. 6:14-18 14 ¶ Do not be bound together with unbelievers; for what partnership have righteousness and lawlessness, or what fellowship has light with darkness? 15 Or what harmony has Christ with Belial, or what has a believer in common with an unbeliever? 16 Or what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; just as God said, "I WILL DWELL IN THEM AND WALK AMONG THEM; AND I WILL BE THEIR GOD, AND THEY SHALL BE MY PEOPLE. 17 "Therefore, COME OUT FROM THEIR MIDST AND BE SEPARATE," says the Lord. "AND DO NOT TOUCH WHAT IS UNCLEAN; And I will welcome you. 18 "And I will be a father to you, And you shall be sons and daughters to Me," Says the Lord Almighty.

<u>Phil. 3:17</u> ¶ Brethren, **join in following my example**, and observe those who walk according to the pattern you have in us.

<u>1 Thess. 1:7</u> so that you became an example to all the believers in Macedonia and in Achaia.

<u>**2 Thess. 3:7</u>** For you yourselves know how **you ought to follow our example**, because we did not act in an undisciplined manner among you,</u>

<u>1 Pet. 2:2</u> like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it **you may** grow in respect to salvation,

<u>2 Pet. 3:18</u> but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him *be* the glory, both now and to the day of eternity. Amen.

<u>Eph. 4:15</u> but speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all *aspects* into Him who is the head, *even* Christ,

<u>2 Thess. 3:13</u> But as for you, brethren, **do not grow weary of doing good**.

<u>1 Cor. 1:9</u> God is faithful, through whom you were called into fellowship with His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

<u>1 Cor. 10:13</u> No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and **God is faithful,** who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, so that you will be able to endure it.

<u>Psa. 73:1</u> ¶ Surely **God is good to** Israel, To those who are pure in heart!

<u>Phil. 4:19</u> And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

<u>1 Tim. 6:17</u> ¶ Instruct those who are rich in this present world not to be conceited or to fix their hope on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, who richly supplies us with all things to enjoy.

<u>1 Pet. 4:11</u> Whoever speaks, *is to do so* as one who is speaking the utterances of God; whoever serves *is to do so* as one who is serving by **the strength which God supplies**; so that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belongs the glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

<u>2 Cor. 5:7</u> for we walk by faith, not by sight —

<u>Heb. 13:15</u> Through Him then, let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that give thanks to His name.
