Sunday, March 3, 2024 Sermon Scriptures

<u>Acts 2:22-24, 36</u> <u>22</u> ¶ "Men of Israel, listen to these words: Jesus the Nazarene, a man attested to you by God with miracles and wonders and signs which God performed through Him in your midst, just as you yourselves know — <u>23</u> this *Man*, delivered over by the predetermined plan and foreknowledge of God, you nailed to a cross by the hands of godless men and put *Him* to death. <u>24</u> "But God raised Him up again, putting an end to the agony of death, since it was impossible for Him to be held in its power.

<u>Acts 2:36</u> ¶ "Therefore let all the house of Israel know for certain that God has made Him both Lord and Christ — **this Jesus whom you crucified.**"

Acts 4:8-12 8 Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them, "Rulers and elders of the people, 9 if we are on trial today for a benefit done to a sick man, as to how this man has been made well, 10 let it be known to all of you and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead — by this *name* this man stands here before you in good health. 11 "He is the STONE WHICH WAS REJECTED by you, THE BUILDERS, *but* WHICH BECAME THE CHIEF CORNER *stone*. 12 "And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved."

Acts 6:8, 12, ¶ And Stephen, full of grace and power, was performing great wonders and signs among the people.

Acts 6:12 And they stirred up the people, the elders and the scribes, and they came up to him and dragged him away and brought him **before the Council**.

<u>Acts 7:51-60</u> <u>51</u> ¶ "You men who are stiff-necked and uncircumcised in heart and ears are **always resisting the Holy Spirit**; you are doing just as your fathers did. <u>52</u> "Which one of **the prophets did your fathers not persecute**? They killed those who had previously announced the coming of the Righteous One, **whose betrayers and murderers you have now become**; <u>53</u> you who received the law as ordained by angels, and *yet* did not keep it." <u>54</u> ¶ Now when they heard this, they were cut to the quick, and **they began gnashing their teeth at him**. <u>55</u> But **being full of the Holy Spirit**, he gazed intently into heaven and saw the glory of God, and **Jesus standing at the right hand of God**; <u>56</u> and he said, "Behold, I see the heavens opened up and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God." <u>Acts 7:57</u> But they cried out with a loud voice, and **covered their ears and rushed at him with one impulse.** <u>58</u> When they had driven him out of the city, **they** *began* **stoning** *him;* and the witnesses laid aside their robes **at the feet of a young man named Saul.** <u>59</u> They went on stoning Stephen as he called on *the Lord* and said, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit!" <u>60</u> Then falling on his knees, he cried out with a loud voice, "Lord, do not hold this sin against them!" **Having said this, he fell asleep**.

<u>John 8:24</u> "Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for unless you believe that I am *He*, you will die in your sins."

Matt. 28:18-20 18 And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Luke 24:45-4845Then He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures,46and He said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ would suffer and rise againfrom the dead the third day,47and that repentance for forgiveness of sins would beproclaimed in His name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem.48Witnesses of these things.

<u>John 17:20</u> ¶ "I do not ask on behalf of these alone, but for those also who believe in Me through their word;

<u>Acts 1:8</u> but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth."

<u>Acts 8:1, 2</u> 1 ¶ Saul was in hearty agreement with putting him to death. ¶ And on that day a great persecution began against the church in Jerusalem, and they were all scattered throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria, except the apostles. <u>2</u> Some devout men buried Stephen, and made loud lamentation over him.

<u>Acts 9:3-16</u> <u>3</u> As he was traveling, it happened that he was approaching Damascus, and suddenly a light from heaven flashed around him; <u>4</u> and he fell to the ground and heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?" <u>5</u> And he said, "Who are You, Lord?" And He *said*, "I am Jesus whom you are persecuting, <u>6</u> but get up and enter the city, and it will be told you what you must do." <u>7</u> The men who traveled with him stood speechless, hearing the voice but seeing no one.

<u>8</u> Saul got up from the ground, and **though his eyes were open, he could see nothing**; and leading him by the hand, they brought him into Damascus. <u>9</u> And he was three days **without sight, and neither ate nor drank**. Acts 9:10 ¶ Now there was a disciple at Damascus named Ananias; and the Lord said to him in a vision, "Ananias." And he said, "Here I am, Lord." <u>11</u> And the Lord *said* to him, "Get up and go to the street called Straight, and inquire at the house of Judas for a **man from Tarsus named Saul**, for he is praying, <u>12</u> and he has seen in a vision a man named Ananias come in and lay his hands on him, so that he might regain his sight." <u>13</u> But Ananias answered, "Lord, I have heard from many about this man, how much harm he did to Your saints at Jerusalem; <u>14</u> and here he has authority from the chief priests to bind all who call on Your name." <u>15</u> But the Lord said to him, "**Go, for he is a chosen instrument of Mine, to bear My name before the Gentiles and kings and the sons of Israel; <u>16</u> for I will show him how much he must suffer for My name's sake."** 

<u>Acts 22:21, 22</u> 21 "And He said to me, 'Go! For I will send you far away to the Gentiles." <u>22</u> ¶ They listened to him up to this statement, and *then* they raised their voices and said, "Away with such a fellow from the earth, for he should not be allowed to live!"

Acts 26:15-20 15 "And I said, 'Who are You, Lord?' And the Lord said, 'I am Jesus 16 'But get up and stand on your feet; for this purpose I whom you are persecuting. have appeared to you, to appoint you a minister and a witness not only to the things which you have seen, but also to the things in which I will appear to you; 17 rescuing you from the *Jewish* people and from the Gentiles, to whom I am sending 18 to open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light and from vou. the dominion of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.' **19** "So, King Agrippa, I did not prove disobedient to the heavenly vision, 20 but *kept* declaring both to those of Damascus first, and *also* at Jerusalem and *then* throughout all the region of Judea, and even to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, performing deeds appropriate to repentance.

<u>Eph. 1:1</u> ¶ Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, ¶ To the saints who are at Ephesus and *who are* faithful in Christ Jesus:

**<u>1Cor. 1:1</u>** ¶ **Paul, called** *as* **an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God**, and Sosthenes our brother,

<u>Gal. 1:1</u> ¶ Paul, an apostle (not *sent* from men nor through the agency of man, but through Jesus Christ and God the Father, who raised Him from the dead),

<u>Acts 1:8</u> but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth."
