## Sermon Scriptures

**Acts 7:35** ¶ “**This Moses whom they disowned**, saying, ‘WHO MADE YOU A RULER AND A JUDGE?’ is the one whom God sent *to be* both a ruler and a deliverer with the help of the angel who appeared to him in the thorn bush.

**Deut. 18:15** ¶ “The LORD your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your countrymen, **you shall listen to him.**

**Acts 3:22, 23** **22** “Moses said, ‘THE LORD GOD WILL RAISE UP FOR YOU A PROPHET LIKE ME FROM YOUR BRETHREN; **TO HIM YOU SHALL GIVE HEED to everything He says to you.** **23** ‘And it will be that **every soul that does not heed that prophet shall be utterly destroyed from among the people.**’

**Isa. 9:6** For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; **And the government will rest on His shoulders;** And His name will be called **Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.**

**Isa. 53:1** ¶ **Who has believed our message?** And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?

**Matt. 3:1-6** **1** ¶ Now in those days **John the Baptist came, preaching** in the wilderness of Judea, saying, **2** “**Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.**” **3** For this is the one referred to by Isaiah the prophet when he said, “THE VOICE OF ONE CRYING IN THE WILDERNESS, ‘**MAKE READY THE WAY OF THE LORD, MAKE HIS PATHS STRAIGHT!**’” **4** Now John himself had a garment of camel’s hair and a leather belt around his waist; and his food was locusts and wild honey. **5** Then Jerusalem was **going out to him**, and all Judea and all the district around the Jordan; **6** and **they were being baptized by him** in the Jordan River, as **they confessed their sins.**

**Matt. 3:7-12** **7** ¶ But when **he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees** coming for baptism, he said to them, “**You brood of vipers, who warned you to flee from the wrath to come?** **8** “Therefore **bear fruit in keeping with repentance;** **9** and do not suppose that you can say to yourselves, ‘We have Abraham for our father’; for I say to you that **from these stones God is able to raise up children to Abraham.** **10** “The axe is already laid at the root of the trees; therefore every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire.

**Matt. 3:11** ¶ “As for me, I baptize you **with water for repentance**, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, and I am not fit to remove His sandals; **He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.** **12** “His winnowing fork is in His hand, and He will thoroughly clear His threshing floor; and He will gather His wheat into the barn, but He will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.”

**Matt. 4:17** ¶ From that time **Jesus began to preach and say**, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.”

**John 8:24** “Therefore I said to you that **you will die in your sins**; for **unless you believe that I am He**, you will die in your sins.”

**Luke 10:13** ¶ “**Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida!** For if the miracles had been performed in Tyre and Sidon which occurred in you, they would have repented long ago, sitting in sackcloth and ashes.

**Matt. 23:13, 14** **13** ¶ “**But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites**, because you shut off the kingdom of heaven from people; for you do not enter in yourselves, nor do you allow those who are entering to go in. **14** [“**Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites**, because you devour widows’ houses, and for a pretense you make long prayers; therefore you will receive greater condemnation.]

**Zech. 9:9** **Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion!** Shout *in triumph*, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, **your king is coming to you**; He is just and endowed with salvation, Humble, and mounted on a donkey, Even on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

**Matt. 21:1-5** **1** ¶ When they had approached Jerusalem and had come to Bethphage, at the Mount of Olives, then Jesus sent two disciples, **2** saying to them, “Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied *there* and a colt with her; untie them and bring them to Me. **3** “If anyone says anything to you, you shall say, ‘The Lord has need of them,’ and immediately he will send them.” **4** This took place to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet: **5** “**SAY TO THE DAUGHTER OF ZION, ‘BEHOLD YOUR KING IS COMING TO YOU, GENTLE, AND MOUNTED ON A DONKEY, EVEN ON A COLT, THE FOAL OF A BEAST OF BURDEN.’**”

**Mark 11:5, 6** **5** Some of the bystanders were saying to them, “What are you doing, untying the colt?” **6** They spoke to them just as Jesus had told *them*, and they gave them permission.

**Matt. 21:6, 7** **6** The disciples went and did just as Jesus had instructed them, **7** and brought the donkey and the colt, and laid their coats on them; and He sat on the coats.

**Matt. 21:8** Most of the crowd spread their coats in the road, and others were **cutting branches from the trees and spreading them in the road.**

**Mark 11:8** And many spread their coats in the road, and others *spread* leafy branches which they had cut from the fields.

**Matt. 21:9** The crowds going ahead of Him, and those who followed, **were shouting, “Hosanna to the Son of David; BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD; Hosanna in the highest!”**

**Mark 11:9, 10** **9** Those who went in front and those who followed were shouting: “Hosanna! BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD; **10** Blessed *is* the coming kingdom of our father David; Hosanna in the highest!”

**Luke 19:37, 38** **37** As soon as He was approaching, near the descent of the Mount of Olives, **the whole crowd of the disciples began to praise God joyfully** with a loud voice **for all the miracles** which they had seen, **38** shouting: **“BLESSED IS THE KING WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD; Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!”**

**John 12:17, 18** **17** So the people, who were with Him when He called Lazarus out of the tomb and raised him from the dead, continued to testify *about Him*. **18 For this reason also the people went and met Him**, because they heard that He had performed this sign.

**Luke 19:41** ¶ When He approached *Jerusalem*, He saw the city **and wept over it**,

**Luke 19:42-44** **42** saying, “If you had known in this day, even you, the things which make for peace! But now **they have been hidden from your eyes.** **43** “For the days will come upon you when your enemies will throw up a barricade against you, and surround you and hem you in on every side, **44** and they will level you to the ground and your children within you, and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because **you did not recognize the time of your visitation.**”

**2 Pet. 2:5** and **did not spare the ancient world**, but preserved Noah, a preacher of righteousness, with seven others, when He brought **a flood upon the world of the ungodly;**

**Acts 4:12** “And there is **salvation in no one else**; for there is **no other name** under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved.”

**John 14:6** Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life; **no one comes to the Father but through Me.**

**Rom. 5:8** But God demonstrates **His own love toward us**, in that while we were yet sinners, **Christ died for us**.

**Rom. 6:23** For the wages of sin is death, but **the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord**.

**Acts 1:10, 11** **10** And as they were gazing intently into the sky while He was going, behold, two men in white clothing stood beside them. **11** They also said, “Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into the sky? **This Jesus, who has been taken up from you into heaven, will come in just the same way as you have watched Him go into heaven.**”

**Rev. 19:11** ¶ And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on it *is* called Faithful and True, and **in righteousness He judges and wages war**.

**Rev. 19:14** And **the armies which are in heaven**, clothed in fine linen, white *and* clean, were following Him on white horses.

**Rev. 19:15** From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down **the nations**, and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and **He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty**.
