Sunday, March 24, 2024 Sermon Scriptures

Acts 7:35 ¶ "This Moses whom they disowned, saying, 'WHO MADE YOU A RULER AND A JUDGE?' is the one whom God sent *to be* both a ruler and a deliverer with the help of the angel who appeared to him in the thorn bush.

Deut. 18:15 ¶ "The LORD your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your countrymen, **you shall listen to him**.

Acts 3:22, 23 22 "Moses said, 'THE LORD GOD WILL RAISE UP FOR YOU A PROPHET LIKE ME FROM YOUR BRETHREN; TO HIM YOU SHALL GIVE HEED to everything He says to you. 23 'And it will be that every soul that does not heed that prophet shall be utterly destroyed from among the people.'

<u>Isa. 9:6</u> For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.

<u>Isa. 53:1</u> ¶ Who has believed our message? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?

Matt. 3:1-6 1 ¶ Now in those days John the Baptist came, preaching in the wilderness of Judea, saying, 2 "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

3 For this is the one referred to by Isaiah the prophet when he said, "THE VOICE OF ONE CRYING IN THE WILDERNESS, 'MAKE READY THE WAY OF THE LORD, MAKE HIS PATHS STRAIGHT!'" 4 Now John himself had a garment of camel's hair and a leather belt around his waist; and his food was locusts and wild honey.

5 Then Jerusalem was going out to him, and all Judea and all the district around the Jordan; 6 and they were being baptized by him in the Jordan River, as they confessed their sins.

Matt. 3:7-12 7 ¶ But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees coming for baptism, he said to them, "You brood of vipers, who warned you to flee from the wrath to come? 8 "Therefore bear fruit in keeping with repentance; 9 and do not suppose that you can say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham for our father'; for I say to you that from these stones God is able to raise up children to Abraham. 10 "The axe is already laid at the root of the trees; therefore every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire.

Matt. 3:11 ¶ "As for me, I baptize you with water for repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, and I am not fit to remove His sandals; He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. 12 "His winnowing fork is in His hand, and He will thoroughly clear His threshing floor; and He will gather His wheat into the barn, but He will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire."

Matt. 4:17 ¶ From that time Jesus began to preach and say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

<u>John 8:24</u> "Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for unless you believe that I am *He*, you will die in your sins."

<u>Luke 10:13</u> ¶ "Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the miracles had been performed in Tyre and Sidon which occurred in you, they would have repented long ago, sitting in sackcloth and ashes.

Matt. 23:13, 14 13 ¶ "But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites, because you shut off the kingdom of heaven from people; for you do not enter in yourselves, nor do you allow those who are entering to go in. 14 ["Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites, because you devour widows' houses, and for a pretense you make long prayers; therefore you will receive greater condemnation.]

Zech. 9:9 Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout *in triumph,* O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, **your king is coming to you**; He is just and endowed with salvation, Humble, and mounted on a donkey, Even on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

- Matt. 21:1-5 1 ¶ When they had approached Jerusalem and had come to Bethphage, at the Mount of Olives, then Jesus sent two disciples, 2 saying to them, "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied *there* and a colt with her; untie them and bring them to Me. 3 "If anyone says anything to you, you shall say, 'The Lord has need of them,' and immediately he will send them." 4 This took place to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet: 5 "SAY TO THE DAUGHTER OF ZION, 'BEHOLD YOUR KING IS COMING TO YOU, GENTLE, AND MOUNTED ON A DONKEY, EVEN ON A COLT, THE FOAL OF A BEAST OF BURDEN."
- Mark 11:5, 6 5 Some of the bystanders were saying to them, "What are you doing, untying the colt?" 6 They spoke to them just as Jesus had told *them*, and they gave them permission.
- Matt. 21:6, 7 6 The disciples went and did just as Jesus had instructed them, 7 and brought the donkey and the colt, and laid their coats on them; and He sat on the coats.

- Matt. 21:8 Most of the crowd spread their coats in the road, and others were cutting branches from the trees and spreading them in the road.
- Mark 11:8 And many spread their coats in the road, and others *spread* leafy branches which they had cut from the fields.
- <u>Matt. 21:9</u> The crowds going ahead of Him, and those who followed, were shouting, "Hosanna to the Son of David; BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD; Hosanna in the highest!"
- Mark 11:9, 10 9 Those who went in front and those who followed were shouting: "Hosanna! BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD; 10 Blessed *is* the coming kingdom of our father David; Hosanna in the highest!"
- <u>Luke 19:37, 38</u> 37 As soon as He was approaching, near the descent of the Mount of Olives, the whole crowd of the disciples began to praise God joyfully with a loud voice for all the miracles which they had seen, 38 shouting: "BLESSED IS THE KING WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD; Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"
- <u>John 12:17, 18</u> 17 So the people, who were with Him when He called Lazarus out of the tomb and raised him from the dead, continued to testify *about Him*.

 18 For this reason also the people went and met Him, because they heard that He had performed this sign.

<u>Luke 19:41</u> ¶ When He approached *Jerusalem*, He saw the city **and wept over it**,

<u>Luke 19:42-44</u> <u>42</u> saying, "If you had known in this day, even you, the things which make for peace! But now they have been hidden from your eyes. <u>43</u> "For the days will come upon you when your enemies will throw up a barricade against you, and surround you and hem you in on every side, <u>44</u> and they will level you to the ground and your children within you, and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not recognize the time of your visitation."

<u>2 Pet. 2:5</u> and did not spare the ancient world, but preserved Noah, a preacher of righteousness, with seven others, when He brought a flood upon the world of the ungodly;

- Acts 4:12 "And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved."
- <u>John 14:6</u> Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

<u>Rom. 5:8</u> But God demonstrates **His own love toward us**, in that while we were yet sinners, **Christ died for us**.

Rom. 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Acts 1:10, 11 10 And as they were gazing intently into the sky while He was going, behold, two men in white clothing stood beside them. 11 They also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into the sky? This Jesus, who has been taken up from you into heaven, will come in just the same way as you have watched Him go into heaven."

Rev. 19:11 ¶ And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on it *is* called Faithful and True, and **in righteousness He judges and wages war.**

Rev. 19:14 And the armies which are in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white *and* clean, were following Him on white horses.

Rev. 19:15 From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty.
