Easter 6AM, March 31, 2024 Sermon Scriptures <u>Psa. 16:10</u> For You will not abandon my soul to Sheol; Nor will You allow Your Holy One to undergo decay.

Acts 13:34, 35 34 "As for the fact that He raised Him up from the dead, no longer to return to decay, He has spoken in this way: 'I WILL GIVE YOU THE HOLY and SURE blessings OF DAVID.' <u>35</u> "Therefore He also says in another *Psalm*, 'YOU WILL NOT ALLOW YOUR HOLY ONE TO UNDERGO DECAY.'

<u>Matt. 20:18, 19</u> <u>18</u> "Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem; and the Son of Man will be delivered to the chief priests and scribes, and they will condemn Him to death, <u>19</u> and will hand Him over to the Gentiles to mock and scourge and crucify *Him*, **and on the third day He will be raised up.**"

<u>Mark 9:9</u> \P As they were coming down from the mountain, He gave them orders not to relate to anyone what they had seen, **until the Son of Man rose from the dead.**

Mark 14:28 "But after I have been raised, I will go ahead of you to Galilee."

John 2:19-2219Jesus answered them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I willraise it up."20The Jews then said, "It took forty-six years to build this temple, andwill You raise it up in three days?"21But He was speaking of the temple of Hisbody.22So when He was raised from the dead, His disciples remembered that Hesaid this; and they believed the Scripture and the word which Jesus had spoken.

<u>**Gen. 1:1**</u> In the beginning **God created** the heavens and the earth.

<u>Gen. 1:2</u> The earth was formless and void, and darkness was over the surface of the deep, and **the Spirit of God was moving over** the surface of the waters.

<u>John 1:1-3</u> 1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was in the beginning with God. 3 All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being.

<u>Acts 2:24</u> "But God raised Him up again, putting an end to the agony of death, since it was impossible for Him to be held in its power.

Acts 3:14 "But you disowned the Holy and Righteous One and asked for a murderer to be granted to you,

<u>Acts 3:15</u> but put to death the Prince of life, *the one* whom God raised from the dead, *a fact* to which we are witnesses.

Eph. 1:19, 20 19 and what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe. *These are* in accordance with the working of the strength of His might **20** which He brought about in Christ, **when He raised Him from the dead** and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly *places*,

John 10:18 "No one has taken it away from Me, but I lay it down on My own initiative. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again. This commandment I received from My Father."

<u>Rom. 1:4</u> who was declared the Son of God with power by the resurrection from the dead, according to the **Spirit of holiness**, Jesus Christ our Lord,

<u>Rom. 4:25</u> *He* who was delivered over because of our transgressions, and **was raised** because of our justification.

<u>Rom. 8:34</u> who is the one who condemns? Christ Jesus is He who died, yes, **rather who was raised**, who is at the right hand of God, **who also intercedes for us**.

<u>1 John 5:11-13</u> 11 And the testimony is this, that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. **<u>12</u>** He who has the Son has the life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have the life. **<u>13</u>** ¶ These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know that you have eternal life.

<u>Luke 23:55</u> Now the women who had come with Him out of Galilee **followed**, and saw the tomb and how His body was laid. <u>56</u> Then they returned and prepared spices and perfumes. \P And on the Sabbath they rested according to the commandment.

<u>Luke 24:1-3</u> 1 ¶ But on the first day of the week, at early dawn, they came to the tomb bringing the spices which they had prepared. 2 And they found the stone rolled away from the tomb, 3 but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus.

<u>Luke 24:4-7</u> <u>4</u> While they were perplexed about this, behold, **two men suddenly** stood near them in dazzling clothing; <u>5</u> and as *the women* were terrified and bowed their faces to the ground, *the men* said to them, "Why do you seek the living One among the dead? <u>6</u> "He is not here, but He has risen. Remember how He spoke to you while He was still in Galilee, <u>7</u> saying that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again." <u>Matt. 28:5-7</u> <u>5</u> The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid; for I know that you are looking for Jesus who has been crucified. <u>6</u> "He is not here, for He has risen, just as He said. Come, see the place where He was lying. <u>7</u> "Go quickly and tell His disciples that He has risen from the dead; and behold, He is going ahead of you into Galilee, there you will see Him; behold, I have told you."

<u>Mark 16:9</u> ¶ [Now after He had risen early on the first day of the week, **He first** appeared to Mary Magdalene, from whom He had cast out seven demons.

<u>John 20:1</u> ¶ Now on the first *day* of the week **Mary Magdalene came early to the tomb**, **while it was still dark**, and saw the stone *already* taken away from the tomb.

<u>John 20:2</u> So she ran and came to Simon Peter and to the other disciple whom Jesus loved, and said to them, "They have taken away the Lord out of the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid Him."

John 20:11-18 11 ¶ But Mary was standing outside the tomb weeping; and so, as she wept, **she stooped and looked into the tomb**;

<u>12</u> and **she saw two angels in white** sitting, one at the head and one at the feet, where the body of Jesus had been lying.

<u>13</u> And they said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping?" She said to them, "Because they have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid Him."

<u>14</u> When she had said this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing *there*, and did not know that it was Jesus.

<u>15</u> Jesus said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?" **Supposing Him to be the gardener**, she said to Him, "Sir, if you have carried Him away, tell me where you have laid Him, and I will take Him away."

<u>16</u> Jesus said to her, "Mary!" She turned and said to Him in Hebrew, "Rabboni!" (which means, Teacher).

<u>17</u> Jesus said to her, "Stop clinging to Me, for I have not yet ascended to the Father; but go to My brethren and say to them, 'I ascend to My Father and your Father, and My God and your God.""

<u>18</u> Mary Magdalene came, **announcing to the disciples**, "I have seen the Lord," and *that* **He had said** these things to her.

<u>Matt. 28:8, 9</u> 8 ¶ And they left the tomb quickly with fear and great joy and ran to report it to His disciples.

<u>9</u> And **behold**, **Jesus met them and greeted them**. And they came up and took hold of His feet **and worshiped Him**.

<u>Luke 24:9-11</u> 9 and returned from the tomb and **reported all these things to the eleven and to all the rest.**

Luke 24:10 Now they were Mary Magdalene and Joanna and Mary the *mother* of James; also the other women with them **were telling these things to the apostles**.

<u>Luke 24:11</u> But these words appeared to them as nonsense, and they would not believe them.

John 20:3-10 3 So Peter and the other disciple went forth, and they were going to the tomb.

<u>4</u> The **two were running together**; and the other disciple ran ahead faster than Peter and came to the tomb first;

<u>5</u> and stooping and looking in, he saw the linen wrappings lying *there;* but he did not go in.

<u>6</u> And so Simon Peter also came, following him, and entered the tomb; and he saw the linen wrappings lying *there*,

<u>7</u> and **the face-cloth** which had been on His head, not lying with the linen wrappings, but **rolled up in a place by itself**.

 $\underline{8}$ So the other disciple who had first come to the tomb **then also entered**, and he saw and believed.

<u>9</u> For **as yet they did not understand the Scripture**, that **He must rise again** from the dead.

<u>10</u> So the disciples went away again to their own homes.
