Sunday, April 21, 2024 Sermon Scriptures

<u>Luke 12:32</u> "Do not be afraid, little flock, for your Father has chosen gladly to give you the kingdom.

Matt. 25:34 ¶ "Then the King will say to those on His right, 'Come, you who are blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world.

<u>Gen. 49:10</u> "The scepter shall not depart from Judah, Nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, Until Shiloh comes, And to him *shall be* the obedience of the peoples.

<u>Isa. 9:6, 7 6</u> For a child will be born to us, **a son will be given to us**; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, **Mighty God**, Eternal Father, **Prince of Peace**. <u>7</u> There will be no end to the increase of *His* government or of peace, On the throne of David and over his kingdom, To establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness From then on and forevermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will accomplish this.

<u>John 3:3, 5, 7</u> Jesus answered and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again **he cannot see** the kingdom of God." <u>5</u> Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit **he cannot enter** into the kingdom of God. <u>7</u> "Do not be amazed that I said to you, 'You must be born again.'

<u>1 Cor. 6:9, 10 9</u> ¶ Or do you not know that **the unrighteous will not** inherit the kingdom of God? **Do not be deceived; neither** fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals, $\underline{10}$ nor thieves, nor *the* covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers, will inherit the kingdom of God.

Gal. 5:19-21 19 Now the deeds of the flesh are evident, which are: immorality, impurity, sensuality, 20 idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, disputes, dissensions, factions, 21 envying, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these, of which I forewarn you, just as I have forewarned you, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

Eph. 5:5 For this you **know with certainty, that no immoral** or impure person or covetous man, who is an idolater, **has an inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and** God.

<u>Luke 13:27-29</u> 27 and He will say, 'I tell you, I do not know where you are from; DEPART FROM ME, ALL YOU EVILDOERS.' 28 "In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth when you see Abraham and Isaac and Jacob and all the prophets in the kingdom of God, but yourselves being thrown out. 29 "And they will come from east and west and from north and south, and will recline *at the table* in the kingdom of God.

Rev. 11:15 ¶ Then the seventh angel sounded; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, ¶ "The kingdom of the world has become *the kingdom* of our Lord and of His Christ; and He will reign forever and ever."

Rev. 19:6 Then I heard *something* like the voice of a great multitude and like the sound of many waters and like the sound of mighty peals of thunder, saying, ¶ "Hallelujah! For the Lord our God, the Almighty, reigns.

Gen. 15:18 On that day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, "To your descendants I have given this land, From the river of Egypt as far as the great river, the river Euphrates:

Psa. 105:8-11 8 ¶ He has remembered His covenant forever, The word which He commanded to a thousand generations, **9** *The covenant* which He made with Abraham, And His oath to Isaac. **10** Then He confirmed it to Jacob for a statute, To Israel as an everlasting covenant, **11** Saying, "To you I will give the land of Canaan As the portion of your inheritance,"

Rom. 8:19-21 19 For the anxious longing of the creation waits eagerly for the revealing of the sons of God. 20 For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it, in hope 21 that the creation itself also will be set free from its slavery to corruption into the freedom of the glory of the children of God.

Rev. 22:3 There will **no longer be any curse**; and the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in it, and His bond-servants will serve Him;

Gen. 3:17-19 17 Then to Adam He said, "Because you have listened to the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree about which I commanded you, saying, 'You shall not eat from it'; Cursed is the ground because of you; In toil you will eat of it All the days of your life. 18 "Both thorns and thistles it shall grow for you; And you will eat the plants of the field; 19 By the sweat of your face You will eat bread, Till you return to the ground, Because from it you were taken; For you are dust, And to dust you shall return."

- **Isa. 35:1** ¶ The wilderness and the desert will be glad, And the Arabah will rejoice **and blossom**; Like the crocus
- <u>Isa. 43:19</u> "Behold, I will do something new, Now it will spring forth; Will you not be aware of it? I will even make a roadway in the wilderness, Rivers in the desert.
- Mic. 4:1-4 1 ¶ And it will come about in the last days That the mountain of the house of the LORD Will be established as the chief of the mountains. It will be raised above the hills, And the peoples will stream to it. 2 Many nations will come and say, "Come and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD And to the house of the God of Jacob, That He may teach us about His ways And that we may walk in His paths." For from Zion will go forth the law, Even the word of the LORD from Jerusalem. 3 And He will judge between many peoples And render decisions for mighty, distant nations. Then they will hammer their swords into plowshares And their spears into pruning hooks; Nation will not lift up sword against nation, And never again will they train for war. 4 Each of them will sit under his vine And under his fig tree, With no one to make them afraid, For the mouth of the LORD of hosts has spoken.

<u>Isa. 65:18, 19</u> 18 "But be glad and rejoice forever in what I create; For behold, I create Jerusalem *for* rejoicing And her people *for* gladness. <u>19</u> "I will also rejoice in Jerusalem and be glad in My people; And there will no longer be heard in her The voice of weeping and the sound of crying.

Zeph. 3:14-17 14 ¶ **Shout for joy, O daughter of Zion**! Shout *in triumph,* O Israel! Rejoice and exult with all *your* heart, O daughter of Jerusalem! **15** The LORD has taken away *His* judgments against you, He has cleared away your enemies. The King of Israel, **the LORD, is in your midst**; You will fear disaster no more. **16** In that day it will be said to Jerusalem: "Do not be afraid, O Zion; Do not let your hands fall limp. **17** "The LORD your God is in your midst, A victorious warrior. **He will exult over you with joy,** He will be quiet in His love, He will rejoice over you with shouts of joy.

<u>Isa. 65:20</u> "No longer will there be in it an infant who lives but a few days, Or an old man who does not live out his days; For the youth will die at the age of one hundred And the one who does not reach the age of one hundred Will be thought accursed.

<u>Psa. 22:27, 28 27</u> All the ends of the earth will remember and turn to the LORD, And all the families of the nations will worship before You. <u>28</u> For the kingdom is the LORD'S **And He rules over the nations**.

<u>Psa. 72:8-11</u> 8 ¶ May he also rule from sea to sea And from the River to the ends of the earth.

Psa. 72:9 Let the nomads of the desert bow before him, And his enemies lick the dust. 10 Let the kings of Tarshish and of the islands bring presents; The kings of Sheba and Seba offer gifts. 11 And let all kings bow down before him, All nations serve him.

Rev. 12:5 And she gave birth to a son, a male *child*, who is to rule all the nations with a rod of iron; and her child was caught up to God and to His throne.

Rom. 14:17 for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.

Isa. 11:9 They will not hurt or destroy in all My holy mountain, For the earth will be full of the knowledge of the LORD As the waters cover the sea.

<u>Isa. 11:6-8</u> ¶ And the wolf will dwell with the lamb, And the leopard will lie down with the young goat, And the calf and the young lion and the fatling together; And a little boy will lead them.

<u>7</u> Also the cow and the bear will graze, Their young will lie down together, And the lion will eat straw like the ox.

 $\underline{8}$ The nursing child will play by the hole of the cobra, And the weaned child will put his hand on the viper's den.

<u>Isa. 65:25</u> "The wolf and the lamb will graze together, and the lion will eat straw like the ox; and dust will be the serpent's food. They will do no evil or harm in all My holy mountain," says the LORD.
