Sermon Scriptures

Rev. 6:8 I looked, and behold, an ashen horse; and he who sat on it had the name Death; and Hades was following with him. Authority was given to them over a fourth of the earth, to kill with sword and with famine and with pestilence and by the wild beasts of the earth.

Rev. 9:13-21 **13** ¶ Then the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God, **14** one saying to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, “Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates.”

15 And the four angels, who had been prepared for the hour and day and month and year, were released, so that they would kill a third of mankind. **16** The number of the armies of the horsemen was two hundred million; I heard the number of them.

17 And this is how I saw in the vision the horses and those who sat on them: *the riders* had breastplates *the color* of fire and of hyacinth and of brimstone; and the heads of the horses are like the heads of lions; and out of their mouths proceed fire and smoke and brimstone. **18** A third of mankind was killed by these three plagues, by the fire and the smoke and the brimstone which proceeded out of their mouths. **19** For the power of the horses is in their mouths and in their tails; for their tails are like serpents and have heads, and with them they do harm. **20** ¶ The rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, did not repent of the works of their hands, so as not to worship demons, and the idols of gold and of silver and of brass and of stone and of wood, which can neither see nor hear nor walk; **21** and they did not repent of their murders nor of their sorceries nor of their immorality nor of their thefts.

Rev. 16:1, 2, 8-11 **1** ¶ Then I heard a loud voice from the temple, saying to the seven angels, “Go and pour out on the earth the seven bowls of the wrath of God.” **2** ¶ So the first *angel* went and poured out his bowl on the earth; and it became a loathsome and malignant sore **on the people who had the mark of the beast and who worshiped his image.**

Rev. 16:8-11 **8** ¶ The fourth *angel* poured out his bowl upon the sun, and it was given to it to scorch men with fire. **9** Men were scorched with fierce heat; and they blasphemed the name of God who has the power over these plagues, and they did not repent so as to give Him glory. **10** ¶ Then the fifth *angel* poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and his kingdom became darkened; and they gnawed their tongues because of pain, **11** and they blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores; and they did not repent of their deeds.

Ezek. 37:26-28 **26** “I will make a covenant of peace with them; it will be an everlasting covenant with them. And I will place them and multiply them, and will set My sanctuary in their midst forever. **27** “My dwelling place also will be with them; and I will be their God, and they will be My people. **28** “And the nations will know that I am the LORD who sanctifies Israel, when My sanctuary is in their midst forever.””

Psa. 22:27, 28 **27** **All the ends of the earth will remember and turn to the LORD,** And all the families of the nations will worship before You. **28** For the kingdom is the LORD’S **And He rules over the nations.**

Psa. 72:8-11 **8** ¶ May he also rule from sea to sea And from the River to the ends of the earth. **9** Let the nomads of the desert bow before him, And his enemies lick the dust. **10** Let the kings of Tarshish and of the islands bring presents; The kings of Sheba and Seba offer gifts. **11** And let all kings bow down before him, **All nations serve him.**

Zech. 14:9 ¶ And the LORD **will be king over all the earth;** in that day the LORD will be *the only* one, and His name *the only* one.

Zech. 14:16 ¶ Then it will come about that any who are left of all the nations that went against Jerusalem will go up **from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts,** and to celebrate the Feast of Booths.

Rev. 12:5 And she gave birth to a son, a male *child*, **who is to rule all the nations with a rod of iron;** and her child was caught up to God and to His throne.

Rev. 19:15 From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and **He will rule them with a rod of iron;** and He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty.

Zech. 14:17-19 **17** And it will be that whichever of the families of the earth does not go up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, there will be no rain on them. **18** If the family of Egypt does not go up or enter, then no *rain will fall* on them; it will be the plague with which the LORD smites the nations who do not go up to celebrate the Feast of Booths. **19** This will be the punishment of Egypt, and the punishment of all the nations who do not go up to celebrate the Feast of Booths.

2 Tim. 2:12 If we endure, **we will also reign with Him;** If we deny Him, He also will deny us;

Rev. 5:10 “You have made them *to be* a kingdom and priests to our God; **and they will reign upon the earth.**”

Rev. 20:6 Blessed and holy is the one who has **a part in the first resurrection**; over these the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and **will reign with Him for a thousand years.**

Rom. 14:17 for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.

Isa. 11:9 They **will not hurt or destroy in all My holy mountain**, For the earth will be full of the knowledge of the LORD As the waters cover the sea.

Isa. 11:6-8 6 ¶ And the wolf will dwell with the lamb, And the leopard will lie down with the young goat, And the calf and the young lion and the fatling together; And a little boy will lead them.

7 Also the cow and the bear will graze, Their young will lie down together, And the lion will eat straw like the ox.

8 The **nursing child will play by the hole of the cobra**, And the weaned child will put his hand on the viper's den.

Isa. 65:25 "The **wolf and the lamb will graze together**, and the lion will eat straw like the ox; and dust will be the serpent's food. **They will do no evil or harm in all My holy mountain,**" says the LORD.
