Sermon Scriptures

<u>Heb. 6:10</u> For God is not unjust so as to forget **your work** and the love which you have shown toward His name, **in having ministered and in still ministering to the saints.**

<u>Titus 3:14</u> Our people must also learn to engage in good deeds to meet pressing needs, so that they will not be unfruitful.

<u>2 Cor. 9:8</u> And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance **for every good deed**;

<u>1 Tim. 6:18</u> *Instruct them* **to do good, to be rich in good works**, to be generous and ready to share,

Col. 3:12-14 12 ¶ So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience; 13 bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you. 14 Beyond all these things put on love, which is the perfect bond of unity.

<u>Gal. 5:13</u> ¶ For you were called to freedom, brethren; only *do* not *turn* your freedom into an opportunity for the flesh, **but through love serve one** another.

<u>Col. 3:23</u> Whatever you do, **do your work heartily, as for the Lord** rather than for men,

Acts 9:36 ¶ Now in Joppa there was a disciple named Tabitha (which translated *in Greek* is called Dorcas); this woman was abounding with deeds of kindness and charity which she continually did.

Rev. 14:13 ¶ And I heard a voice from heaven, saying, "Write, 'Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on!" "Yes," says the Spirit, "so that they may rest from their labors, **for their deeds follow with them**."

<u>Col. 3:24</u> knowing that **from the Lord you will receive the reward** of the inheritance. It is the Lord Christ whom you serve.

<u>Psa. 24:1</u> ¶ The earth is the LORD'S, and all it contains, The world, and those who dwell in it.

<u>1 Cor. 10:26</u> FOR THE EARTH IS THE LORD'S, **AND ALL IT CONTAINS.**

<u>Luke 6:38</u> "Give, and it will be given to you. They will pour into your lap a good measure — pressed down, shaken together, and running over. For by your standard of measure it will be measured to you in return."

<u>Luke 6:35</u> "But love your enemies, and do good, and **lend, expecting nothing in return; and your reward will be great,** and you will be sons of the Most High; for He Himself is kind to ungrateful and evil *men*.

<u>1 Cor. 4:2</u> In this case, moreover, it is required of stewards that one be found trustworthy.

<u>1 Pet. 4:10</u> As each one has received a *special* gift, **employ it in serving one** another as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.
