-Acts 17:13-34 -

(Character Study - Paul)

- I. UNBELIEVING JEWS FROM THESSALONICA TRACK PAUL TO BEREA AND OPPOSE HIM THERE
 - A. They Found Uut He Was Preaching The Word Of God There Also, v-13a
 - B. They Kept Agitating And Stirring Up The Crowds v-13b --Satan wanted mankind to stay lost.
- II. THE BELIEVING BRETHREN SENT PAUL AWAY
 - A. As Far As The Sea And Silas And Timothy Stayed With Them, v-14a
 - B. They Escorted Paul As Far As Athens, v-15a
 - C. Paul Gave Them A Command For Silas And Timothy To Come As Soon As Possible, v-15b
- III. PAUL WAS MOVED IN HIS SPIRIT AT ATHENS BECAUSE OF SO MANY IDOLS, TO WITNESS THERE, v-16-18 --Their lostness was in his face!
 - A. He Was Reasoning In The Synagogue, v-17a
 - B. He Reasoned In The Market Place Every Day,17b
 - C. The Philosophers Were Conversing With Him,18
 - 1. Epicurean and Stoic, v-18a
 - 2. To some he was an idle babbler, v-18b
 - 3. To others he was proclaiming new gods,18c
 - 4. He was preaching Jesus and the resurrection v-18d
 - D. They Invited Paul To The Areopagus To Speak To Them To Explain His New Teaching, v-19, 20
 - E. They Use To Spend Their Time Telling And Hearing New Things, v-21
- IV. PAUL BEGINS TO SPEAK TO THEM, v-22-23
 - A. He Noticed That They Were Very Religious, v-22
 - B. He Was Examining Their Objects Of Worship,23a
 - C. He Found An Altar To "The Unknown God"v-23b
- V. PAUL EXPLAINS TO THEM THE UNKNOWN GOD, A. He Made All Things, v-24a; Gen. 1:1; Isa.44:2
