Sunday, October 13, 2024 Sermon Scriptures

Matt. 7:21-23 21 ¶ "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven will enter. 22 "Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?' Matt. 7:23 "And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; DEPART FROM ME, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS.'

- John 3:1, 3, 5, 7 1 ¶ Now there was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews; 3 Jesus answered and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God." 5 Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. 7 "Do not be amazed that I said to you, 'You must be born again.'
- <u>1 Pet. 1:3</u> ¶ Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us **to be born again to a living hope** through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,
- <u>Titus 3:5</u> He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit,
- <u>John 1:12, 13</u> But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, *even* to those who believe in His name, 13 who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.
- $\underline{1 \text{ Tim. 4:1}}$ ¶ But the Spirit explicitly says that in later times some will fall away from the faith, paying attention to deceitful spirits and doctrines of demons,

Psa. 119:140 Your word is very pure, Therefore Your servant loves it.

2 Tim. 4:1-3 ¶ I solemnly charge *you* in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by His appearing and His kingdom: **2 preach the word**; be ready in season *and* out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction. **3** For the time will come when **they will not endure sound doctrine**; but *wanting* **to have their ears tickled**, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance to their own desires,

- <u>1Pet. 2:2</u> like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may grow in respect to salvation,
- **Eph. 4:15** but speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all aspects into Him who is the head, even Christ,
- <u>2 Cor. 11:13, 14</u> 13 For such men are **false apostles, deceitful workers**, disguising themselves as apostles of Christ. <u>14</u> No wonder, for **even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light.**
- Rom. 12:1, 2 1 ¶ Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship. 2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.
- **Phil. 4:2** ¶ I urge Euodia and I urge Syntyche to live in harmony in the Lord.
- <u>James 1:22-25</u> <u>22</u> But prove yourselves doers of the word, and not merely hearers who delude themselves. <u>23</u> For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks at his natural face in a mirror; <u>24</u> for *once* he has looked at himself and gone away, he has immediately forgotten what kind of person he was. <u>25</u> But one who looks intently at the perfect law, the *law* of liberty, and abides by it, not having become a forgetful hearer **but an effectual doer**, this man will be blessed in what he does.
- Acts 20:28-30 28 "Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood. 29 "I know that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; 30 and from among your own selves men will arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after them.
- <u>1 Cor. 1:10-13</u> <u>10</u> ¶ Now I exhort you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all agree and **that there be no divisions among you**, but that you be made complete in the same mind and in the same judgment. <u>11</u> For I have been informed concerning you, my brethren, by Chloe's *people*, that there are quarrels among you. <u>12</u> Now I mean this, that each one of you is saying, "I am of Paul," and "I of Apollos," and "I of Cephas," and "I of Christ." <u>13</u> Has Christ been divided? Paul was not crucified for you, was he? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul?
- **Eph. 4:31** Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor **and slander** be put away from you, along with all malice.

<u>James 3:6, 8</u> And the tongue is a fire, the *very* world of iniquity; the tongue is set among our members as that which defiles the entire body, and sets on fire the course of *our* life, and is set on fire by hell.

<u>James 3:8</u> But no one can tame the tongue; *it is* a restless evil *and* full of deadly poison.

<u>John 13:34</u> "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

<u>1 John 3:23</u> ¶ This is His commandment, that we believe in the name of His Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, just as He commanded us.

Eph. 4:32 Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, **forgiving each other**, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

Eph. 4:3 being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

<u>John 14:23</u> Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our abode with him.

Rom. 16:17, 18 17 ¶ Now I urge you, brethren, keep your eye on those who cause dissensions and hindrances contrary to the teaching which you learned, and turn away from them. 18 For such men are slaves, not of our Lord Christ but of their own appetites; and by their smooth and flattering speech they deceive the hearts of the

unsuspecting.

- **2 Thess. 3:10-12 10** For even when we were with you, we used to give you this order: if **anyone is not willing to work, then he is not to eat, either. 11** For we hear that some among you are leading an undisciplined life, doing no work at all, but acting like busybodies. **12** Now such persons we command and exhort in the Lord Jesus Christ to work in quiet fashion and eat their own bread.
- <u>1 Cor. 5:1, 2, 9-13</u> ¶ It is actually reported that **there is immorality among you**, and immorality of such a kind as does not exist even among the Gentiles, that someone has his father's wife. <u>2</u> You have become arrogant and **have not mourned instead**, so that the one who had done this deed **would be removed from your midst**.
- 9¶ I wrote you in my letter not to associate with immoral people; 10 I did not at all mean with the immoral people of this world, or with the covetous and swindlers, or with idolaters, for then you would have to go out of the world. 11 But actually, I wrote to you **not to associate with any so-called brother if he is an immoral person, or** covetous, or an idolater, or a reviler, or a drunkard, or a swindler not even to eat with such a one.

<u>1 Cor. 5:12</u> For what have I to do with judging outsiders? Do you not judge those who are within *the church*? <u>13</u> But those who are outside, God judges. **REMOVE THE WICKED MAN FROM AMONG YOURSELVES.**

Matt. 18:15-17 15 ¶ "If your brother sins, go and show him his fault in private; if he listens to you, you have won your brother.

<u>16</u> "But if he does not listen *to you*, take one or two more with you, so that BY THE **MOUTH OF TWO OR THREE WITNESSES** EVERY FACT MAY BE CONFIRMED

<u>17</u> "If he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church; and if he refuses to listen even to the church, let him be to you as a Gentile and a tax collector.

<u>1 John 1:9</u> If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
