<u>Phil. 4:15, 16</u> 15 ¶ You yourselves also know, Philippians, that at the first preaching of the gospel, after I left Macedonia, no church shared with me in the matter of giving and receiving but you alone; 16 for even in Thessalonica you sent a gift more than once for my needs.

Acts 16:14, 15 14 A woman named Lydia, from the city of Thyatira, a seller of purple fabrics, a worshiper of God, was listening; and the Lord opened her heart to respond to the things spoken by Paul. 15 And when she and her household had been baptized, she urged us, saying, "If you have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, come into my house and stay." And she prevailed upon us.

Acts 16:22-34 22 The crowd rose up together against them, and the chief magistrates tore their robes off them and proceeded to order them to be beaten with 23 When they had struck them with many blows, they threw them into prison, commanding the jailer to guard them securely; 24 and he, having received such a command, threw them into the inner prison and fastened their feet in the stocks. 25 ¶ But about midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns of praise to God, and the prisoners were listening to them; 26 and suddenly there came a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison house were shaken; and immediately all the doors were opened and everyone's chains were unfastened. 27 When the jailer awoke and saw the prison doors opened, he drew his sword and was about to kill 28 But Paul cried out with a loud himself, supposing that the prisoners had escaped. voice, saying, "Do not harm yourself, for we are all here!" 29 And he called for lights and rushed in, and trembling with fear he fell down before Paul and Silas, **30** and after he brought them out, he said, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" 31 Thev said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household." 32 And they spoke the word of the Lord to him together with all who were in his 33 And he took them that very hour of the night and washed their wounds, and immediately he was baptized, he and all his *household*. **34** And he brought them into his house and set food before them, and rejoiced greatly, having believed in God with his whole household.

<u>Luke 11:1, 2</u> 1 ¶ It happened that while Jesus was praying in a certain place, after He had finished, one of His disciples said to Him, "Lord, teach us to pray just as John also taught his disciples." <u>2</u> And He said to them, "When you pray, say: 'Father, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come.

**Eph. 1:1, 2** 1 ¶ Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, ¶ To the saints who are at Ephesus and *who are* faithful in Christ Jesus:  $\underline{2}$  Grace to you and peace **from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ**.

We know that when He appears, we will be like Him, because we will see Him just as He is. <u>3</u> And everyone who has this hope fixed on Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.

<u>Phil. 2:16</u> holding fast the word of life, so that in the day of Christ I will have reason to glory because I did not run in vain nor toil in vain.
