Sunday, November 17, 2024 Sermon Scriptures

Gen. 2:18 ¶ Then the LORD God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone; I will make him a helper suitable for him."

Gen. 2:22 And the LORD God fashioned into a woman the rib which He had taken from the man, and brought her to the man. 23 And the man said, "This is now bone of my bones, And flesh of my flesh; She shall be called Woman, Because she was taken out of Man." 24 For this cause a man shall leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave to his wife; and they shall become one flesh. 25 And the man and his wife were both naked and were not ashamed.

Gen. 1:26,27 26 Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; and let them rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over the cattle and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

27 And God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

Matt. 19:3-8 3 ¶ And some Pharisees came to Him, testing Him, and saying, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for any cause at all?" 4 And He answered and said, "Have you not read, that He who created them from the beginning made them male and female, 5 and said, For this cause a man shall leave his father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife; and the two shall become one flesh? 6 "Consequently they are no longer two, but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let no man separate." 7 They said to Him, "Why then did Moses command to give her a certificate of divorce and send her away?" 8 He said to them, "Because of your hardness of heart, Moses permitted you to divorce your wives; but from the beginning it has not been this way.

2 Cor. 6:14 ¶ Do not be bound together with unbelievers; for what partnership have righteousness and lawlessness, or what fellowship has light with darkness?

<u>1 Cor. 7:39</u> ¶ A wife is bound as long as her husband lives; but if her husband is dead, she is free to be married to whom she wishes, only in the Lord.

<u>1 Cor. 7:2</u> But because of immoralities, let each man have his own wife, and let each woman have her own husband.

<u>1 Cor. 6:18-20</u> <u>18</u> Flee immorality. Every other sin that a man commits is outside the body, but the immoral man sins against his own body.

<u>1 Cor. 6:19</u> Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own? <u>20</u> For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body.

Gen. 16:1-4 1 Now Sarai, Abram's wife had borne him no children, and she had an Egyptian maid whose name was Hagar. 2 So Sarai said to Abram, "Now behold, the LORD has prevented me from bearing children. Please go in to my maid; perhaps I shall obtain children through her." And Abram listened to the voice of Sarai. 3 And after Abram had lived ten years in the land of Canaan, Abram's wife Sarai took Hagar the Egyptian, her maid, and gave her to her husband Abram as his wife. 4 And he went in to Hagar, and she conceived; and when she saw that she had conceived, her mistress was despised in her sight.

Gen. 29:26-28 26 But Laban said, "It is not the practice in our place, to marry off the younger before the first-born. 27 "Complete the week of this one, and we will give you the other also for the service which you shall serve with me for another seven years."

28 And Jacob did so and completed her week, and he gave him his daughter Rachel as his wife.

Matt. 5:27, 28 27 "You have heard that it was said, 'You shall not commit adultery';

28 but I say to you, that everyone who looks on a woman to lust for her has committed adultery with her already in his heart.

Rom. 1:25-27 25 For they exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen. $26 \, \P$ For this reason God gave them over to degrading passions; for their women exchanged the natural function for that which is unnatural, 27 and in the same way also the men abandoned the natural function of the woman and burned in their desire toward one another, men with men committing indecent acts and receiving in their own persons the due penalty of their error.

Rom. 1:18 ¶ For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,

<u>Rom. 2:5</u> But because of your stubbornness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God,

<u>1 Cor. 6:9-11</u> <u>9</u> Or do you not know that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals, <u>10</u> nor thieves, nor the covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers, shall inherit the kingdom of God. <u>11</u> And such were some of

you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, and in the Spirit of our God.

Eph. 5:22-24 22 Wives, be subject to your own husbands, as to the Lord. **Eph. 5:23** For the husband is the head of the wife, as Christ also is the head of the church, He Himself being the Savior of the body. **24** But as the church is subject to Christ, so also the wives ought to be to their husbands in everything.

<u>Col. 3:18</u> Wives, be subject to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord.

<u>1 Pet. 3:1</u> ¶ In the same way, you wives, be submissive to your own husbands so that even if any of them are disobedient to the word, they may be won without a word by the behavior of their wives.

Eph. 5:33b Nevertheless let each individual among you also love his own wife even as himself; and let the wife see to it that she respect her husband.

Eph. 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her;

Eph. 5:28-30 28 So husbands ought also to love their own wives as their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself; **29** for no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ also does the church, **30** because we are members of His body.

<u>Eph. 5:33</u>a Nevertheless let each individual among you also love his own wife even as **himself**; and let the wife see to it that she respect her husband.

Col. 3:19 Husbands, love your wives, and do not be embittered against them.

<u>1 Pet. 3:7</u> ¶ You husbands likewise, live with your wives in an understanding way, as with a weaker vessel, since she is a woman; and grant her honor as a fellow heir of the grace of life, so that your prayers may not be hindered.

<u>Titus 2:4, 5</u> 4 that they may encourage the young women to love their husbands, to love their children, <u>5</u> to be sensible, pure, workers at home, kind, being subject to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be dishonored.

Eph. 6:4 And, fathers, do not provoke your children to anger; but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

Col. 3:21 Fathers, do not exasperate your children, that they may not lose heart.

Eph. 6:1-3 1 ¶ Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. your father and mother (which is the first commandment with a promise), be well with you, and that you may live long on the earth. $\underline{2}$ Honor $\underline{3}$ that it may
