<u>Phil. 4:6</u> Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.

<u>Phil. 4:7</u> And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

**Phil. 4:10** ¶ But I rejoiced in the Lord greatly, that now at last you have **revived your concern for me**; indeed, you were concerned *before*, but you lacked opportunity.

- **Phil. 4:11** Not that I speak from want, for I have learned to be content in whatever circumstances I am.
- <u>Phil. 4:12</u> I know how to get along with humble means, and I also know how to live in prosperity; in any and every circumstance I have learned the secret of being filled and going hungry, both of having abundance and suffering need.
- Phil. 4:13 I can do all things through Him who strengthens me.
- <u>Phil. 4:14</u> Nevertheless, you have **done well to share** *with me* in my affliction.
- <u>Phil. 4:15</u> ¶ You yourselves also know, Philippians, that at the first preaching of the gospel, after I left Macedonia, no church shared with me in the matter of giving and receiving but you alone;
- **Phil. 4:16** for even in Thessalonica **you sent** *a gift* **more than once** for my needs.
- Phil. 4:17 Not that I seek the gift itself, but I seek for the profit which increases to your account.
- <u>Phil. 4:18</u> But I have received everything in full and have an abundance; I am amply supplied, having received from Epaphroditus what you have sent, a fragrant aroma, an acceptable sacrifice, well-pleasing to God.
- <u>Phil. 4:19</u> And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.
